The Mauritius Ports Authority (MPA) is pleased to invite sealed bids from local and overseas bidders for the Construction of a Cruise Terminal Building at Port Louis Harbour.

The scope of works includes amongst others construction of:

- (i) a steel structure of ground floor area approximately 7,500 m², on raft and pad footings;
- (ii) pavement works together with all necessary infrastructural facilities; and
- (iii) associated works

Qualification requirements

- The Contractor, either as single entity or joint venture or association, must hold a valid registration with CIDB as follows: -
Class of Work: Building Construction Works as Grade A together with Civil Engineering Works as Grade C and Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing Works(MEP) as Grade C.
- The Bidder must demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments to meet the following cash-flow requirement of MUR 100,000,000 (or equivalent in USD/EURO/GBP)
- Other qualifying criteria mentioned in the bid document
