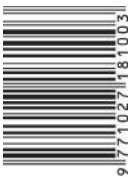

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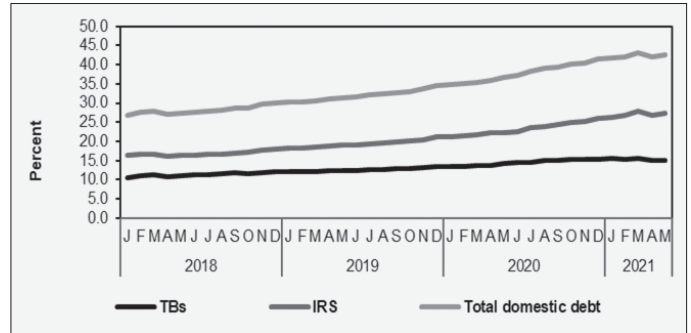
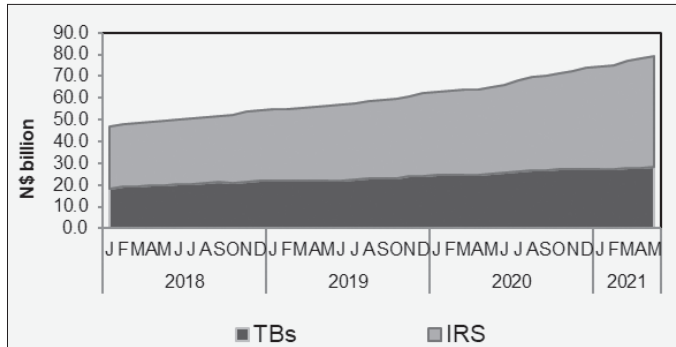
# GRN DOMESTIC DEBT GROWS 21.5% TO N\$79.1-B

04 JUNE 2021

Namibia's domestic government debt rose to N\$79.1 billion during May 2021, according to the Bank of Namibia's latest monthly report.

This reflects a 1.2% increase

from the previous month, reflected in the issuance of both Treasury Bills (TBs) and Internal Registered Stock (IRS), which rose by 0.9% and 1.3% respectively to N\$28.2-b and N\$50.8-b.



On an annual basis, domestic debt increased by 21.5%, with IRSs issued rising 27.7% and TBs by 11.7%.

As a percentage of GDP, domestic debt rose during May to 0.5 percentage point month-on-month

to 42.4%, while annually, the ratio of domestic debt to GDP, rose by 5.9 percentage points, reflecting an increase in IRSs and TBs issued by 4.9 percentage points and 1.0 percentage points respectively, to 27.3% and 15.1%.

# OTJIKOTO BIOMASS POWER PROJECT MANAGEMENT

04 JUNE 2021

A joint venture comprising Fichtner GmbH from Germany and Namibian firms Lund Consulting Engineers with Pregon Consulting Engineers, will provide technical advisory and project management services for NamPower's Otjikoto biomass power station, according to the Central Procurement Board of Namibia, who issued the tender on behalf of the power utility.

Request for proposal tender SC/RFP/CPBN-02/2020 closed on 23-Feb-21 with the joint venture submitting the only offer.

The tender was awarded on 12-May-21 for N\$55,728,460 excluding VAT, with a contract period of 60 months, according to the CPB's website. The cost estimate was N\$60-m excluding VAT. This award notice was also published in *New Era* of 06-May-21.

The RFP followed an expression of interest process under tender SC/EOI/CPBN-01/2020 for the short-listing of consultants, closing 17-Aug-20, after which eleven consultants were short-listed (*Bulletin* 1372) and considered for the RFP in which technical and financial offers were requested.

Tenderers had to commit themselves to form a joint venture between a Namibian consulting firm

## Only one out of eleven short-listed consultants submitted a bid - Fichtner/Lund/Pregon joint venture awarded the contract for N\$55.7-m

and an international consultant, while they also had to ensure maximum skills and knowledge transfer to NamPower staff and the local consultants.

## The project

The 44ha Otjikoto Biomass Power Project site owned by NamPower is in the Oshikoto Region along the B1 national road close to the existing Otjikoto Substation, with Tsumeb as the nearest town.

The 40 MWe Otjikoto Biomass Power Station will generate electricity by the combustion of wood chips from encroacher bush, which is harvested from the surrounding areas of the proposed project site.

According to NamPower, a total of 39.2-m tonnes of biomass wood chips can be conservatively extracted from a 100km radius from the project site.

This implies that the 40MWe Otjikoto Biomass Project can be sustained for about 200 years, operating 70% capacity.

The total cost of the Otjikoto Biomass Power Station is estimated at N\$1.878-b (at an assumed exchange rate of USD/NAD 14), according to NamPower's project

fact sheet.

NamPower will procure an EPC Contractor to engineer, procure and construct the power plant through a transparent and open international competitive bidding process, following the Public Procurement Act.

The pre-qualification process for the EPC contractors and boiler and grate system suppliers was launched by the CPB under tender W/OIB/CPBN-1/2021 (EPC contractors for the Otjikoto Biomass Power Station) that closed on 10-Mar-21, for which the bid opening record could not be accessed on the CPB website until late May.

NamPower and then Ministry of Agriculture, Water & Forestry, together with the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH – Bush Control and Biomass Utilisation (BCBU) Project, and supported by the Namibia Biomass Industry Group (N-BIG), had commissioned a macroeconomic study in 2018 to quantify and assess the project (*Bulletin* 1365).

# CHINESE POWER THEIR WAY INTO NORTHWESTERN SUBSTATIONS

04 JUNE 2021

NamPower's tender for the design and construction of the Kunene and Omatando Substations in northern Namibia has been awarded to Sinohydro Corporation Ltd / Adaptive Building Land Construction cc joint venture N\$340,808,287.38 excluding VAT, according to the Central Procurement Board of Namibia who issued the tender on behalf of the power utility.

Open International Bidding tender W/OIB/CPBN-03/2020 closed on 26-Feb-21 with three offers from only Chinese companies (bids for two lots were published in *Bulletin 1387* - 'Power Stations Made in China').

The tender was awarded on 07-Apr-21 to the bidder with the lowest offer, Sinohydro Corporation Ltd / Adaptive Building Land Construction cc JV, who scored 74.1% in the technical evaluation. The contract period is 20 months.

According to the CPB'S bid opening record, the JV had offered a 2% discount if both lots are awarded, but this was not

mentioned in the award notice.

The cost estimate for this project was N\$447,000,000 excluding VAT.

The unsuccessful bidders and the reasons for disqualification were:

\* China Gezhouba Group International Engineering Ltd / China Gezhouba Group Co Ltd = N\$423,656,348.20 total, who were found to be non-responsive due to not submitting the Written Undertaking, Declaration of Authenticity and Covenant of Integrity for both JV parties. In addition, the Performance Security undertaking was from a non-Namibian financial institution and the Primary Equipment Suppliers form was not

fully completed.

\* Shanghai Electric Company Group Ltd = N\$500,150,000 less N\$22-m discount if both lots are awarded, found to be non-responsive due to adding to the BF1-2 Letter of Bid the exchange rate used and price to exclude duties/ taxes etc. Also, the Performance Security was from a non-Namibian financial institution, other documents were not fully completed and the company details were inconsistent with the Articles of Association.

## The project

According to NamPower's website, the Kunene-Omatando development consists of the construction of a new substation called "Kunene" south of the existing Ruacana Power station.

This substation will be built on 400kV but initially operated at 330kV. A 400kV line will be built from Kunene to the existing Omatando substation to substantially increase the power supply capacity to Oshakati, Ondangwa and surrounding areas.

This line will form part of a bigger future project to create a Northern ring at 400kV and "will ensure redundancy of evacuation of power from the Ruacana Power station, redundant power supply to the Northern regions and cater for the integration of the future Baynes Power Station".

An earlier controversial tender issued by NamPower in 2015 and awarded to Conco Namibia in 2016 for N\$244-m was cancelled after a high court intervention (details in *Bulletin 1386*).

# CHINA'S GRIP TIGHTENS ON NAM'S POWER PROJECTS

**When nine offers were received for the engineering, procurement and construction of the Anixas II power station at Walvis Bay through tender W/EOI/CPBN-01/2020 closing at the Central Procurement Board on behalf of NamPower in October 2020, four of these included joint ventures with only Chinese as main contractors – all of whom have now been prequalified.**

Two of Namibia's three major power station construction projects are now in the hands of Chinese contractors: the Kunene and Omatando substations in the north-west (see separate report in this edition) and the Anixas II power station in Walvis Bay (below), while Chinese contractors are by far in the majority in the running to prequalify for the third - the Otjikoto Biomass Power Station (see separate report in this edition).

On 19 March, the *Tender Bulletin* reported that only four Chinese companies had qualified for the next stage of tendering on NamPower's N\$1-b Anixas II 50MW project power station at Walvis Bay – all with Namibian firms as junior partners.

The Central Procurement Board of Namibia, who issued the tender on behalf of the power utility, posted the notice of prequalification on its website on 05 February.

The announcement came a fortnight before three offers were received from only Chinese companies on another power plant tender - the design and construction of the Kunene and Omatando Substations under tender W/OIB/CPBN-03/2020 that also closed at the CPB on behalf of NamPower on 26 February 2021.

The controversial 2016 Kunene-Omatando tender was cancelled despite a high court order to the contrary, then reissued after conflict-of-interest claims and court litigation involving NamPower's former MD. Oddly, the new tender attracted only Chinese offers,

with three bids from N\$340-m to N\$500-m, with no sign of the previous contenders – Siemens, Alstom and Conco (*Bulletin 1387*).

The Anixas II Walvis Bay tender, W/EOI/CPBN-01/2020, was an expression of interest for the procurement of a contractor for the Engineering, Procurement and Construction of Anixas II Power Station that closed 19-Oct-20 with nine offers (*Bulletin 1378*).

Tender W/EOI/CPBN-01/2020 was an expression of interest for the procurement of a contractor for the Engineering, Procurement and Construction of Anixas II Power Station that closed 19-Oct-20 with nine offers (*Bulletin 1376*).

When the nine offers were received for the engineering, procurement and construction of the Anixas II power station through tender W/EOI/CPBN-01/2020 closing at the Central Procurement Board on Monday 19 October 2020, four of these included joint ventures with Chinese as main contractors – all of whom have now been prequalified.

The 05-Feb-21 CPB notice of prequalification of the same four bidders was already announced on 19-Nov-20:

\* Jiangsu Etern Co Ltd / CCC Engineering Ltd / Octagon Construction (Pty) Ltd Joint Venture;

\* China Gezhouba Group Co Ltd / China Energy Engineering Group / Guangdong Power Engineering Co. Ltd / Hue-Waldt Electrical & Construction cc JV;

\* Sinohydro Corporation Ltd / Adaptive Building & Land Construction JV;

\* Dongfang Electric International Corporation / China Henan International Corporation Group Co Ltd / Faraday's Electrical & Mechanical JV.

These four joint venture companies were invited to participate in the next stage of a Restricted Bidding process.

The estimated contract value was stated in the CPB Executive Summary of the Bid Evaluation Report as N\$966,000,000 with a completion period of 30 (18) [sic] months.

The unsuccessful bidders were:

\* Aksa Enerji Uretim (Turkey) / Green Enterprise Solutions JV (Aksa failed to provide reference letters);

\* Belgravia Services Ltd (Zambia) / Dalbit International Ltd / Power Electrical & Construction cc JV (the completion certificate provided does not relate the experience required for this project);

\* Matelec Sal (Lebanon) / MP NRG (Pty) Ltd / CSV Construction Namibia / Adenco Construction Namibia JV (CSV did not provide shareholder certificates; while two Namibian IDs provided the roles of those individuals could not be verified in the CSV organisational structure);
