- 1. The Road Development Authority (Mauritius) invites bids for road maintenance and minor works (2020-2023) within a Framework Agreement from eligible and qualified contractors registered with the CIBD (Mauritius) for Civil Engineering Construction Works.
- Contractors who qualify and enter in the framework agreement with the Road Development Authority may be awarded works contracts under the conditions of the agreement based on the criteria of value for money and capacity to execute the works specified.

The works shall consist of routine and periodic road maintenance including but not limited to resurfacing with asphalt concrete, road upgrading such as constructions of footpaths, drains, geometric and structural improvements, realignment of roads, reconstruction of bridges and concrete structures and implementation of road safety measures of all types for the period of contract. These works generally are on main roads and motorways but may also be undertaken on urban roads, rural roads, track roads, yards and premises of public properties in all zones as follows:

Zone North comprises of the districts of Pamplemousses and Riviere du Rempart;

Zone East comprises of the districts of Moka and Flacq;

Zone Central comprises of the district of Plaines Wilhems,

Zone South comprises of the districts of Grand Port and Savanne.

Zone West comprises of the districts of Black River and Port Louis.

- 3. The duration of the framework agreement will be for a maximum of three (3) years.
- 4. The framework documents consist of three volumes. The documents are available <u>for consultation only</u> on the website of the Road Development Authority but they are not to be used for submission.

- 5. A complete set of framework documents in English may be purchased from the Road Development Authority upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Five Thousand Mauritian Rupees (MUR 5,000/-) in cash or by bank cheque in favour of the Road Development Authority. Payment and delivery of documents shall be effected at the Finance Department of the Road Development Authority.
- 6. Alternatively, at the request of the bidder, electronic copy of bidding documents may be sent to the bidders upon payment made via bank transfer to the following account and receipt of a written request providing full contact details of the bidder and relevant document confirming payment of the non-refundable fee for the bidding documents.

The Bidder's application shall contain an e-mail address where bidding documents may be sent to. All banking charges and fees related to the bank transfer (including correspondent bank charges) shall be on the bidder's account. In case the bidder has chosen the electronic copy, the bidder shall be solely responsible for the receipt of such copy of the bidding documents. The bidder must acknowledge the receipt of the said documents by return mail within 48 hours of the receipt failing which it shall be deemed the bidder has received the bidding documents.

Any clarification sought by any bidder in respect with this procurement exercise shall be addressed to the General Manager, Road Development Authority, 8th Floor, Blue Tower, Ebene, Republic of Mauritius so as to reach him at least twenty one(21) days prior to the deadline for the submission of bids.
- 8. Bids shall be in accordance with provisions of the "Instructions to Contractors" incorporated in the invitation for framework documents
- 9. Bids in sealed envelope clearly marked FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE AND MINOR WORKS (2020 2023) and bearing the name and address of the bidder and CPB Reference Number: CPB/15/2020 and indicating the closing date, should be addressed to The Chief Executive, Central Procurement Board and deposited in the Bid Box or sent by courier service or registered post, so as to reach The Chief Executive, Central Procurement Board, , 1st Floor, Social Security House, Julius Nyerere Avenue (ex-Moka Road), Rose Hill, Republic of Mauritius on or before Thursday 20 August 2020 up to 13.30 hrs (local time) at latest. Late bids will be rejected.

The bids will be opened physically in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person as from 14.00 hrs (Local time) on the same day.
