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PHD Chamber's Viewpoint

The growing severity of widespread pandemic COVID-19 on our economy is a matter of deep concern. PHD Chamber of Commerce stands in complete solidarity and pledges to extend its all-out support to the Government in the fight for making India COVID-19 free. We urge the government to provide an increased stimulus relief package of Rs 16 lakh crore which is around 7% of GDP sooner than later to mitigate the impact of Pandemic COVID-19 on economy, trade and Industry through various relief measures and benefits. An automatic increase of 25% in working capital without any procedure and application to reduce stress on businesses; to convert increased working capital in a term-loan with a provision of 3 years repayment period are crucial at this juncture.

The proactive and combative measures undertaken by the Government to curtail the spread of pandemic COVID-19 are highly appreciable. Immediate reduction in the lending rate by all the banks to percolate the full effect of recent 75 basis points cut in repo rate by RBI should be done. To defer the EMIs of the term-loans for 6 months, special interest subvention @ 3% in loans to MSMEs and other badly affected industries; to abolish all fixed charges of all the utilities and defer all utilities' bills by 3 months are crucial at this juncture. Release of outstanding payments of MSMEs, from the Government and PSUs; rationalisation of GST rate structure by merging 18% tax slab with 12% tax slab, among others are significant needed in this extremely difficult time.

The reforms undertaken by the Government to contain the spread of COVID-19 in India are highly encouraging. It is suggested that herbs dealers and packing material industries cum dealers should be permitted to work to maintain the smooth supply of raw material/packing materials for manufacturing of medicines by Pharma/Ayush sector. Some of the long terms measures that must be undertaken include reducing income tax of the proprietorship and LLPs firms to the level of 25% for old and 15% for new companies; reduce the customs duties on basic raw materials by at least 5 percentage points; further reduction of 100 basis points repo rate cut are necessary to enhance the competitiveness of manufacturers.

The proactive and fast track measures undertaken by the Government to combat the impact of pandemic COVID-19 on trade and industry are highly appreciable. We are quite optimistic that the Economic Response Task Force will combat the impact of pandemic covid-19 on India's economy, trade and industry. At this juncture, it is recommended that the consumption expenditure by the Government should be enhanced, even if fiscal deficit slips by 2 percentage points to revive the demand scenario in the economy.



Executive Summary

The rapid outbreak of the pandemic COVID-19 presents an alarming health crisis that the world is facing. The impact of the pandemic COVID-19 is unfolding in real time on economy, trade and industry. The severity of the pandemic is increasing each day. Almost all the countries including China, France, USA, Germany, Italy, Spain, UK, among others have been severely impacted. The whole mankind in the world is in huge problem and uncertainty about the severity and spread of pandemic Covid-19. In India, lockdown to control the spread of pandemic COVID-19 has been extended till 3rd May 2020 wherein select additional activities have been allowed from 20th April 2020.

During the past few weeks, Government of India has announced several measures to support economy and industry in these extremely difficult times. The Ministry of Home Affairs has framed consolidated guidelines on the measures to be taken by Ministries/ departments, State and UT Governments for containment of pandemic COVID-19 in the country. The guidelines specify what all services/ establishments can continue to work with bare minimum staff after taking precautions and the activities that are suspended till further notice.

The Ministry of Commerce and Industry has provided a number of relaxations / extensions of various compliance deadlines etc. to address pandemic COVID-19 related hardships of exporters. The relaxations include extension of Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) beyond 31st March 2020, extension of Export Obligation Period, relaxations under provisions of Hand Book of Procedure (HBP), extension of last date for filing annual claims under MEIS & SEIS, relaxations for Special Economic Zone (SEZ) units, relaxations by Export Credit Guarantee Corporation of India for filing returns and claims, among others. Measures have been taken to facilitate preferential exports in the wake of lockdown through digitally signed certificates of origin to the exporters. Furthermore, the Government e-market place (GeM) has taken measures to facilitate procurement and help the buyers and sellers on the platform.

The Ministry of Finance has announced Rs 1.70 Lakh Crore relief package under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana for the poor to help them fight the battle against pandemic COVID-19. The relief package includes Insurance cover of Rs 50 Lakh per health worker, 5 kg wheat or rice and 1 kg of preferred pulses for free for the next three months to 80 crore poor people, Rs 500 per month for next three months for 20 crore women Jan Dhan account holders, increase in MNREGA wage to Rs 202 a day from Rs 182 to benefit 13.62 crore families, among others. The Ministry of Civil Aviation has waived demurrage charges on imports by 50% provided that the cargo, goods, etc. are cleared and removed from the airport by 23:59 hours on 16th April 2020.

PHD Chamber of Commerce industry is keeping a close watch on the impact of pandemic COVID-19 at the national, state and international level. We appreciate the Government for undertaking proactive and fast track measures to combat the impact of pandemic COVID-19 on economy, trade and industry. We urge the Government to provide an increased stimulus relief package of Rs 16 lakh crore which is around 7% of GDP sooner than later through various relief measures and benefits. The Government has already provided a stimulus of around Rs 2 lakh crore, therefore, our expectation is for the remaining Rs 14 lakh crore.

| 1 | Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Department of Commerce, Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) and Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT)) | In order to give relief to businesses and affected individuals amidst the stress caused by the pandemic COVID-19, Ministry of Commerce and Industry has introduced several relaxations and extensions in deadlines etc. with regard to compliances mandated under its schemes and activities. Government has extended the Foreign Trade Policy 2015-2020 till 31.03.2021. The validity of various import-linked export schemes such as Duty-Free Import Authorisation (DFIA) and Export Promotion Capital Goods (EPCG) have been extended by one year. Government has allowed Electronic filling and Issuance of Preferential Certificate of Origin for India's Exports under various FTAs/PTAs w.e.f. 07th April 2020. In view of the movement restrictions in place due to pandemic COVID-19 in India, the designated agencies will issue digitally signed electronic certificates of origin only and no hard copy of the same will be provided. Government has allowed extension till 31.03.2021 in case of one-time condonation under the EPCG Scheme. Therefore, the time period to receive requests for block-wise extension; extension in Export Obligation Period and submission of installation certificate is further extended up to 31.03.2021. Government has amended Export Policy of certain APIs and formulations such as vitamins B1, B6 and B12, tinidazole, metronidazole, acyclovir, progesterone and chloramphenicol, among others from restricted to free. DGFT had earlier restricted the exports of bulk drugs and their formulations to ensure there is no shortage of drugs in India. Government has amended Export Policy of Diagnostic Kits and Ventilators including any artificial respiratory apparatus or oxygen therapy apparatus or any other breathing appliance/device and Sanitizers from restricted to free. Government has provided relaxations on compliances to be met by units / developers / co-developers of SEZs including filing of Quarterly Progress Report (QPR), SOFTEX form to be | |

The Hon'ble Finance Minister, Smt Nirmala Sitharaman also announced several relief measures relating to Statutory and Regulatory compliance matters across Sectors in view of pandemic COVID-19 outbreak. The relaxations relating to Statutory and Regulatory compliance include extension of last date for income tax returns for (FY 18-19) from 31st March, 2020 to 30th June, 2020, 24X7 Custom clearance till end of 30th June, 2020, extension in last date for filling GSTR-3B due in March, April and May 2020 by the last week of June, 2020 for those having aggregate annual turnover less than Rs. 5 Crore, extension of payment date under Sabka Vishwas Scheme till 30th June, 2020, among others. The Reserve Bank of India has allowed Banks to declare a 3-month moratorium on all term loans outstanding as on March 1, 2020, as well as on working capital facilities. Accordingly, the Indian Banks Association has answered a list of Frequently Asked Questions about the technicalities of the moratorium to help businesses/ individuals. | | | |



- RBI has also announced new measures on 17th April 2020 to maintain adequate liquidity in system, facilitate bank credit flow, ease financial stress and enable formal working of markets. Some of the key measures include conducting of TLTRO 2.0 for Rs 50,000 crore, allowing banks to use surplus into economy, reduced reverse repo rate by 25 bps from 4% to 3.75% under LAF; Rs 50,000 crore special finance facility to be provided to financial institutions such as NABARD, SIDBI, NHB; NPA count shall not include the 90-day moratorium period; Liquidity coverage ratio requirement of scheduled commercial banks being brought down from 100% to 80% with immediate effect; all accounts where moratorium or deferment has been applied, there would be an asset classification standstill; loans given by NBFCs to real estate companies to get similar benefit as given by scheduled commercial banks; among others.
- So far under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package more than 32crore poor people have received financial assistance of Rs29,352crore, 5.29 Crore beneficiaries have been distributed free ration of food grains, 97.8 Lakh free Ujjwala cylinders have been delivered, first instalment of PM-KISAN i.e., Rs14,946crore has been transferred to 7.47crore farmers, among others.
- A digital pipeline has been laid by the Government through linking of Jan-Dhan accounts as well as other accounts with the account holders' mobile numbers and Aadhaar [Jan Dhan-Aadhaar-Mobile (JAM). Using the digital payment infrastructure in the country, more than 30 crore poor people have received financial assistance of Rs 28,256 crore under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package announced by Hon'ble Union Finance Minister Smt Nirmala Sitharaman.
- In the context of pandemic COVID-19 situation, the Central Government has granted exemption from Basic Customs Duty and Health cess, on the import of Ventilators, Face masks, surgical Masks, among others, with immediate effect. This basic customs duty exemption shall be available upto the 30th September, 2020.
- The Government has provided relief for third party Motor Insurance & Health policy holders in the light of pandemic COVID-19 lockdown. The Ministry of Finance has issued notifications on April 1, 2020, stating that the renewal dates of Health and Motor insurance policies falling between March 25, 2020, to April 14, 2020, are extended till April 21, 2020 due to lockdown. Therefore, existing policies which are falling due for

The guidelines specify what all services/ establishments can continue to work during the lockdown period with bare minimum staff and the activities that are suspended till further notice. These guidelines are amended from time to time. The Government has decided to extend the lockdown period till 3rd May 2020 to control the spread of pandemic COVID-19 in the country. Thus, the lockdown measures stipulated in the consolidated guidelines of MHA will continue to remain in force till 3rd May 2020. To mitigate the hardship to the public, select additional activities have been allowed from 20th April 2020 such as all health services including AYUSH, agricultural and related activities, financial sector, social sector, MNREGA works, public utilities, movement/loading/unloading of goods/ cargo (inter and intra State), among others. Regular clarifications/ updates are issued from time to time regarding the select additional activities that have been allowed to resume. The Government has constituted six Inter-Ministerial Teams to make assessment of the current COVID-19 situation and augment State efforts to fight and contain spread of COVID-19 effectively. The Government has directed all States and UTs to implement lockdown guidelines in letter & spirit to ensure smooth movement of inter & intrastate cargo, trucks, workers and functioning of warehouse/cold storages, as it has come to the notice of the Ministry that in some parts of the country the guidelines are not being implemented. The Government has reiterated the various guidelines to be observed strictly by the authorities at various levels including inter-state and intra-state movement of all trucks, movement of workers to workplace, smooth functioning of warehouses/ cold storage, smooth functioning of MS | | |



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| | (Marine)/Aquaculture Industry, including feeding and maintenance, harvesting, processing, packaging, cold chain, sale and marketing; hatcheries, feed plants, commercial aquaria, movement of fish/ shrimp and fish products, fish seed/feed and workers for all these activities. The Ministry of Home Affairs, in a continued effort, has written to all State Chief Secretaries to take urgent steps to ensure availability of essential goods, by invoking provisions of the Essential Commodities (EC) Act 1955. These measures include fixing of stock limits, capping of prices, enhancing production, inspection of accounts of dealers and other such actions. The Ministry of Home Affairs has written to all State Chief Secretaries clarifying on ground level issues being faced by States in ensuring smooth flow of supply chain of essential items during national lockdown to fight COVID-19. The clarification concerns daily essentials, laboratories, operations of Railways, Airports and Seaports for cargo movement, interstate and intra-state movement of all trucks and other goods, among others. An addendum to the consolidated guidelines exempts from lockdown restrictions the shops of agricultural machinery, its spare parts (including its supply chain) and repair; truck repair shops on highways, preferably at fuel pumps; and Tea industry, including plantations with maximum of 50% workers. The Ministry of Home Affairs has written to States to ensure Smooth Harvesting and Sowing Operations, while maintaining Social Distancing, during 21-day Lockdown to fight pandemic COVID-19. The Government has exempted specific services from lockdown restrictions such as direct marketing of agricultural produce, food & nutrition support to children, women, lactating mothers by Anganwadi workers and medical services & drug manufacturing under AYUSH category. The Ministry of Home Affairs has written to States/UTs to ensure smooth Disbursal of Money to beneficiaries of PM-GKY during 21-day Lockdo |
