CONTRACT WW 393C - Consultancy Services for Supervision of the Construction of Trunk Sewers, Reticulation Network, House Connections and CWA Pipe Replacement for the Pailles Guibies Sewerage Project

1. The Wastewater Management Authority invites proposals from international eligible firms for the Consultancy Services for the PAILLES GUIBIES SEWERAGE PROJECT – PHASE 2 - Contract WW 393C: Consultancy Services for Supervision of the Construction of Trunk Sewers, Reticulation Network, House Connections and CWA Pipe Replacement for the Pailles Guibies Sewerage Project.
2. A firm will be selected under Open Advertised Bidding and procedures described in the Invitation For Proposals, in accordance with the policies and procedures for public procurement in the Republic of Mauritius.
3.
 - i. Consultants operating in the construction sector have a statutory obligation to be registered with the Constructions Industry Development Board (CIDB) of Mauritius.
 - ii. Foreign consultants as defined in the CIDB Act will have to apply for and obtain a Provisional Registration prior to submitting proposals for this project. If the contract is awarded to a foreign consultant the latter shall have to apply for and obtain a Temporary Registration before starting the project.
 - iii. Consultants whether local or foreign under an existing or intended joint venture will be eligible as a joint venture if, in addition to their respective individual registration, they obtain a Provisional Registration for the joint venture prior to submitting proposals for this project. If an existing or intended joint venture is awarded the contract it shall have to apply for a Temporary Registration prior to starting the project.
 - iv. Sub-consultants undertaking assignments on behalf of main consultants are also subject to registration as applicable to consultants.

- v. A Foreign contractor or consultant referred to in paragraph (3) shall, for the purpose of registration, make an application with the CIDB and obtain a valid registration certificate prior to bidding for this project.
 - vi. Consultants are strongly advised to consult the website of the CIDB cidb.govmu.org for further details concerning registration of consultants.
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- 4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the Invitation for Proposals at the office of **Wastewater Management Authority 6th Floor, The Celicourt Building, Sir Celicourt Antelme Street, Port Louis, Mauritius.**
 - 5. A complete set of the document for the Invitation for Proposals may be purchased by interested firms on the submission of a written application to the above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **MUR 10,000.**
 - 6. A Pre-proposal conference will be held on **29 October 2018** at 10:00 hrs in the Conference Room of the **WMA Head Office 9th Floor, The Celicourt Building, Sir Celicourt Antelme Street, Port Louis, Mauritius,** followed by a site visit.
