

India and USA sign 3 pacts during the State Visit of President of USA to India

The President of USA, Mr. Donald J Trump is on a state visit to India from 24th to 25th February 2020 along with his delegation. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi welcomed the President of USA to India and said that India-USA bilateral relations are no longer just another partnership rather it is a far greater and a closer relationship.

Further, the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India said that both the countries have agreed to start negotiations for a mega trade deal.
