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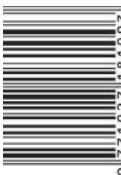

The Ministry of Agriculture, Water & Land Reform has outlined the modalities for implementing its N\$1.42 billion Namibia Agricultural Mechanization & Seed Improvement Project (NAMSIP) following cabinet approval on 5 October 2020 – over two years after the project commenced.

The NAMSIP projects is co-funded through a loan from the African Development Bank under Loan No. 2000200001951 amounting to an estimated N\$1-b (UA50,390,272), with the Namibian government contributing N\$362,174,700.

Although the five-year NAMSIP project commenced in April 2018 and ends in December 2022, the implementation modalities were seemingly only approved by Cabinet on 05-Oct-20.

The programme covering agricultural mechanization, improvement of seed systems and equipment maintenance, has been hampered by procurement problems ever since it began.

The overall project goal is to improve household food and nutrition security by enhancing agricultural productivity and reducing imports of staple foods, facilitating job creation and improving household incomes among rural communities.

NAMSIP's two main components are:

- (1) Value Chain Improvement with 'Agriculture Mechanization' and 'Certified Seed System Improvement' as sub-components;
- (2) Institutional support with 'capacity building' and 'project management' as sub-components.

The NAMSIP programme's target beneficiaries are individual communal farmers or farming co-operatives, associations and organized groups of women and

youth involved in livestock and crop production. Resettled and emerging farmers who obtained land through the Affirmative Action Loan Scheme will also benefit from the programme.

Beneficiaries of 'Agriculture Mechanization' in all fourteen regions are expected to contribute through participation in agricultural activities and payment towards subsidized agricultural services provided on the Dry Land or Rain-Fed Crop Production Programme principles.

Services include ploughing, ripping, planting, fertilizer application, weeding, spraying of pests, harvesting and threshing.

Farmers will also pay a minimal loan fee towards the crop, fodder and animal health equipment.

Beneficiaries for the 'Certified Seed System Improvement' in ten crop-growing regions are expected to participate in seed multiplication activities and buy foundation and subsidised certified seeds for mahangu, maize, sorghum and cowpeas.

In a full-page media statement in local newspapers, the MAWLR undertook to call for expressions of interest from horticulture producers and farmers in the regions to complete application forms and to collaborate with regional councils to create awareness about the benefits of participating in the programme.

ricultural mechanization scheme and the seed systems development scheme, which are key for sustainable crop and livestock value chain improvement.

The project will enhance dry-land crop production, irrigated crop production, state-owned enterprises (SOEs), and private sector operations through effective utilisation of agricultural machinery and equipment for livestock production, "and processing which can be used as launch pads for SME driven industrialization".

The project's development objective is to strengthen household food security and reduce poverty. The project aims specifically to:

- * increase agricultural productivity,
- * promote job creation, and
- * increase household income, which will improve the living conditions of the rural population.

The project will directly benefit 294,500 crop producers/farmers (157,558 female and 136,942 male), plus 10,000 livestock farmers (including 2,500 women livestock farmers).

In addition, 33 extension and veterinary staff will be trained in agricultural mechanisation in order to ably transfer knowledge and skills to the beneficiaries.

The Project will fully support 111 farmer cooperatives with a total membership of 10,681 of whom 6,912 will be women. It will generate 111,240 jobs for men,

women and youth in agricultural production and processing and will also indirectly benefit about 800,000 people along the cereal and livestock value chains, according to the AfDB's website (<https://projectsportal.afdb.org>).

Agricultural mechanization modalities

Modalities for the provision of subsidized services and inputs to crop and fodder producers under rain-fed and irrigation produce stipulate that the government will procure and own all tractors with matching implements based on regional needs.

The MAWLR will provide:

- * subsidized ploughing, ripping, planting, fertilizer application, weeding, spraying of pests, harvesting, and threshing services;
- * subsidized grass harvesting - mowing, raking, and baling services.

The Ministry will provide subsidized inputs (seed and fertilizer) to grain and fodder producing farmers, based on the existing Dry Land Crop Production Program (DCPP);

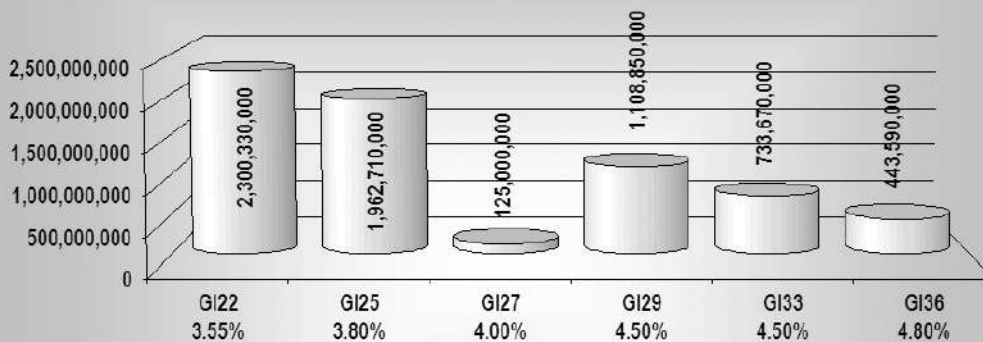
The services will be provided up to a maximum of 10ha per farmer, while those with fields smaller than 1ha will be assisted with hand-operated tractors.

The Ministry will also provide subsidized ploughing and planting services to small-scale communal and resettled horticultural farmers up to a maximum of 3ha.

The MAWLR will provide:

- * subsidized ploughing, ripping, planting, fertilizer application, weeding, spraying of pests, harvesting, and threshing services;
- * subsidized grass harvesting such as mowing, raking, and baling services;
- * subsidized inputs (seed and fertilizer) to grain and fodder producing farmers will be provided up to a maximum of 10ha per farmer, while those with fields below 1ha will be assisted with hand-operated tractors;
- * subsidized ploughing and planting services to small-scale communal and resettled horticultural farmers up to a maximum of 3ha.

Modalities for the installation of equipment for crop, fodder and livestock production stipulate that the MAWLR will supply and install small-scale irrigation systems, green houses, shade nets and water tanks at a fee for identified progressive co-operatives and associations involved in horticultural production in all 14 regions.

Beneficiaries will be expected to maintain and take care of these structures at their own cost.

The MAWLR will call for expressions of interest for horticultural producers (individuals, associations/groups and co-operatives) in all 14 regions and set up greenhouses, irrigation system with water tanks and shade nets at a minimal fee to selected horticultural producers.

It will also:

- * loan out equipment at a minimal fee for horticultural production (hand-operated walking tractors, vegetable seed drillers, vegetable seedling transplanters and weeding cultivators); and
- * provide selected horticultural producers with subsidized mechanized agricultural services and horticultural inputs up to a maximum of 3ha.

As far as modalities for livestock production/marketing equipment, the ministry will procure forty-two (42) animal weighing scales that will be stationed at identified auction kraals.

Seed multiplication modalities

The ministry will:

- * call for expressions of interest for individual farmers, co-operatives and other entities in the ten crop-growing regions to register as potential seed growers for mahangu, maize, sorghum and cowpea;
- * select farmers as seed growers, based on set criteria for seed multiplication.

Selected seed growers will undergo mandatory training on seed multiplication and seed selection, after which it will provide foundation seed of major staple crops (*mahangu, maize, sorghum, and cowpea*) at cost to selected seed growers for up to a maximum of 30ha.

Selected seed growers will be provided with subsidized ploughing, planting and weeding services based on the existing DCPD for up to a maximum of 30ha.

The MAWLR will provide technical backstopping during seed multiplication, such as inspection, seed pre-cleaning and transporting of unprocessed certified seed from farmers' fields to seed processing plants.

Modalities for seed processing plants

The Ministry will:

- * construct five seed processing plants at Omahenene (Omusati region), Okashana (Oshikoto region), Katwitwi (Kavango West), Mashare (Kavango East) and Katima Mulilo (Zambezi region);
- * recruit registered seed processors to operate and manage the seed pro-

cessing plants;

- * enter into contractual agreements with successful operators;
- * buy certified seed from contracted seed growers at agreed prices;
- * transport unprocessed certified seed produced at government institutions to the seed processing plants for processing; and
- * make certified seed available at 50% of the normal price in all regions.

Modalities for machinery and equipment maintenance

Successful tenderers for the supply of machinery and equipment must:

- * guarantee that the machinery and/or equipment conforms to the performance requirement for two years;
- * guarantee that any breakages resulting from defects are replaced at the supplier's cost under a five-year term;
- * provide servicing and maintenance of tractors and ensure availability of spares;
- * provide training of technicians.

The ministry will call for expressions of interest to acquire the services of vocational training graduates in the area of diesel mechanics, auto electrical and welding to service, maintain and repair tractors and implements after the expiry of the warranty.

Successful graduates with different specialization will be grouped into maintenance and service teams, which will serve specific clusters of constituencies in all regions, where they will be contracted and paid on a call-out principle.

The ministry will train selected ministerial technical staff (handyman, artisans and work hands) to undertake on-site minor repairs, servicing and maintenance of tractors and other equipment and will procure and ensure the availability of fuel, lubricants and spare parts.

Procurement opportunities

As far as procurement opportunities are concerned, the MAWLR announcement listed:

- * metal trunks and cooler boxes (for Veterinary Rural Extension Centres),
 - * small-scale irrigation schemes,
 - * green houses, shade nets, water tanks and other infrastructure (equipment for crop, fodder, livestock production), as well as
 - * agricultural machinery (walking tractors, vegetable seed drillers, seedling transplanters and weeding cultivators), plus
 - * 42 animal weighing scales at identified Government Auction Kraals (for livestock production management).
- For the 'Certified Seed System Improvement' programme, the MAWLR intends to construct five seed processing plants in Omahenene (Omusati), Okashana (Oshikoto), Katwitwi (Kavango West),

Mashare (Kavango East) and Katima Mulilo (Zambezi region).

This also involves transportation of seeds to the centres.

Last year's tenders

So far this year, the MAWLR has advertised five agricultural input / equipment tenders with NAMSIP references:

- * G/OCBI/NAMSIP/37-02/2021/2022: 350x tractors with matching implements and fodder equipment, 8x certified seed pre-cleaning machines and 14x prototype pearl millet/cow pea/maize thresher plants (closing 30-Aug-21);
- * G/OCBI/NAMSIP/37-03/2021/2022: 350x diesel chipper hammer mills, 1,647x hand operated weeding cultivators and 1,804x hand operated seedling transplanters (closing 23-Aug-21);
- * G/OCBI/NAMSIP/37-01/2021: 380x walking tractors with matching implements (closing 06-Aug-21) – a re-issue of cancelled tender G/ICB/NAMSIP/20-01/2020/2021 closing 13-Oct-20;

- * G/ONB/NAMSIP/37-13/2020/2021: Agricultural inputs (licks, grass and lucerne) for livestock farmers (closing 14-Jun-21);
- * G/ONB/NAMSIP/37-14/2020/2021: Agricultural inputs (nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium (NPK), ammonium sulphate (ASO4), UREA, MAP and LAN) for crop farmers (closing 31-May-21).

An unreferenced call for applications for progressive individual farmers, farmers' cooperatives and associations to benefit from the installation of solar powered 40kW irrigation systems, green house and shade net sets for horticulture and fodder production closed on 17-May-21.

Another three 'open national bidding NAMSIP tenders closing 09-Apr-21 were for irrigation systems at Mannheim Research Station, Omahenene Research Station and Mashare Irrigation Training Centre.

The *Tender Bulletin* also came across six requests for quotations for NAMSIP that were posted only on the MAWF website and not advertised in the local media:

Sixteen of twenty NAMSIP tenders cancelled in 2020

For 2020, the *Tender Bulletin* is aware of sixteen of the twenty NAMSIP tenders for agricultural inputs having been cancelled.

This includes five tenders for 327 tractors worth N\$420-m flagged by the AfDB, plus a tender for 380 walking tractors.

The five tractor tenders that had closed on 27-Nov-20 were re-issues from Jun-20, when all bidders were found to be non-responsive in terms of Section 5(1)(a) of the Public Procurement Act (*Bulletin* 1353).

According to a report in *The Namibian* of 21-Apr-21, informed sources said a certain company that was awarded several tenders by the MAWLR, had been lobbying behind the scenes to benefit from the tractor tenders as well.

Senior staff members at the MAWLR had privately also raised concerns about alleged corruption (*Bulletin* 1394).

Some of the NAMSIP tenders issued in 2021 are re-issues of the earlier tenders from last year.

These updates are compiled from media reports and Market Namibia & Tender Bulletin's own sources.
