

Intellectual Property (IP) refers to creations of the mind: inventions, literary and artistic works, and symbols, names, images, and designs used in commerce.

In the changing global scenario, the issues of IPR have gained special importance for the Micro, Small & Medium Enterprise (MSME) sector. IPR protection plays a key role in gaining competitive advantage in terms of technological gains for achieving higher economic growth in a market driven economy.

PHDCCI has Intellectual Property Facilitation Centre for Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) supported by Office of Development Commissioner-Ministry of Micro Small & Medium Enterprises. Offering services like drafting of Application /Consultation/Filling/Follow-up for Patents/Copy Rights/Trademarks/Trade Secrets/Industrial Design/Geographical Indication/Present challenges of liberalization & various activities on IPR are proposed under this scheme.

### **ARBITRATION CELL**

PHDCCI has the dedicated ADR Cell of extends institutional service for the Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) of commercial disputes. It administers, oversees and conducts arbitration and conciliation proceedings according to the institutional rules framed by PHD Chamber of Commerce, as modified from time to time, in tune with the changing legal framework and needs of the business community.

The Arbitration Rules of PHDCCI is the backbone of the secretariat acting for institutional arbitration, keeping the parties informed concerning all the steps taken in the neutral and independent administering of the cases on a day-to-day basis and providing the benefits of a quick, efficient and inexpensive mechanism for dispute settlement.

The cell also offers advice on drafting contracts, organizes conferences, seminars, workshops to educate and prepare arbitrators and to spread awareness by conducting awareness programmes in alliance with the leading organizations of prominence.

### CERTIFICATION SERVICES

PHD Chamber has been authorized by the Government of India to issue Certificate of Origin (Non-Preferential) to Indian exporters, in accordance with Article II of the International Convention Relating to Simplification of Customs Formalities, 1923. In addition to issuing the Non Preferential Certificate of Origin, the Chamber also attests/certifies commercial documents for export oriented companies and issues Visa recommendation letter to member companies.
