## SETTING UP A SOLAR POWER PLANT IN REHOBOTH

1. Background

Over the years, the Council of Rehoboth has been receiving applications from individuals and private companies requesting for permission to set up Solar Power Plant(s) and to have a PPA negotiated. These applications have become significant in numbers, that Council cannot provide an assessment for each of them, neither to assess their competitiveness and relevance and / or compliance. Further, under the ECB (Electricity Control Board) supported MSBMM rules, clear guidelines to any future RE solution (Solar) are provided. Hence to identify, on fair and transparent principles, the best partner and long - term cooperation for RTC, a resolution was taken to fairly manage the situation by Calling for Expression of Interests from reputable and experienced local registered companies to participate in the fair and competitive manner to establish a Solar Power Plant in the RTC Distribution License area.

2. Objective

The construction of a Solar Power Plants, and a medium- to long term PPA (Power Purchase Agreement) based on the proposal received under the EOI. The key driver it to benefit ALL residents and businesses on a net lower cost of electricity in Rehoboth Distribution area

3. Provision

RTC (Rehoboth Town Council) will make available the required land (12.5ha) within a 1km distance of the in-feed point to a Main Intake Distribution Station (NamPower-Infeed) to allow the plant to comply to respective grid codes applicable wrt. Visibility and Controllability of the proposed PV plant by the National Transmission

4. Evaluation Criteria

The evaluation criteria will be issued to parties intending to submit a bid, based on a terms sheet that will be distributed accordingly,

Key drivers will be the cost of electricity, tariff structure, escalation over the lifespan of the plant proposed, management of the construction, operation and closure/rehabilitation of site (past useful lifetime) and the position of the submitting party in terms of financial standing, local experience and local resources
