



CONCEPT & BACKGROUND

One of the pillars of the tourism industry has been mankind's inherent desire to see and learn about the cultural identity of different parts of the world. World Heritage Sites are among the most symbolic tourism destinations and attractions, facing numerous challenges due to an ever increasing tourism activity and related development issues. Therefore, it is fundamental that tourism authorities study how best to develop these cultural heritage sites while protecting and preserving them for the long-term.

Today many tourism sites are receiving huge influx of visitors, especially in peak periods that might cause severe management difficulties, deterioration of the visitor experience, as well as the general site conditions. Successful management of congested tourism attractions goes much beyond the sites themselves; it is dependent on the effective coordination between site managers, local authorities, tour operators, transportation companies, information managers at different levels.

PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry aims at illustrating how World Heritage Sites can be integrated into broader regional and destination-level tourism management processes, creating a strong platform to exchange best practices, discuss challenges and opportunities in the Heritage Tourism sector. The **1st India Heritage Tourism Conclave** (IHTC) held on **November 23, 2011** at **New Delhi** was a first of its kind in India. The conclave touched upon all aspects of heritage that we as Indians are proud of, be it our heritage sites, art & crafts, music or cuisine.

In keeping with the success of the 1st IHTC, PHD Chamber organized the 2nd IHTC on November 28, 2012; 3rd IHTC on February 21, 2014; 4th IHTC on February 20, 2015 at New Delhi; 5th IHTC on February 12, 2016 at Jaipur; 6th IHTC from March 16-17, 2017 at Khajuraho and 7th IHTC on March 23, 2018 at Ahmedabad. All the Conclaves proved to be a runaway success.

Taking the legacy forward, PHDCCI is organizing the **8th India Heritage Tourism Conclave** with the theme 'Sustainable Tourism Management at World Heritage Sites' on March **27**, **2019** at WelcomHotel The Savoy, Mussoorie.

The Conclave will address key tourism management issues, such as coordination between heritage management and tourism organizations, extending benefits to local communities, reducing tourism congestion and environmental impacts.
