

December 2018 core infra stands at 2.6 %

The core infrastructure stands at 2.6% in December 2018 as against 3.4% in November 2018. The combined Index of Eight Core Industries stood at 132.1 in December, 2018, which was 2.6% higher as compared to the index of December, 2017. Its cumulative growth during April to December, 2018-19 was 4.8%.

In cumulative terms, core infrastructure industries registered a growth of 4.8% during April-December 2018-19 as against 3.9% during April-December 2017-18.




