



## Government announces amendments in policy conditions under import policy

A. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of FT(D&R) Act, 1992, read with Paragraph 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-2020, as amended from time to time, the Central Government has amended the import policy of polymethyl methacrylate under Exim code 3916 90 32 of ITC (HS) 2017 – Schedule – 1 (Import policy) as under:

**Effect of the notification**: Import policy of seeds of polymethyl methacrylate <u>under Exim code</u> 3916 90 32 of ITC (HS) 2017 – Schedule – 1 (Import policy) is revised from "Free" to "Prohibited" wih effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019.

- B. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of FT(D&R) Act, 1992, read with Paragraph 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-2020, as amended from time to time, the Central Government has inserted a new policy condition, number (12) at the end of chapter 87 of ITC (HS) 2017 Schedule 1 (Import policy)a as under:
- (12) Registration of vehicles imported by the vehicle manufactures or through their authorized representatives in India or by the organization / citizen for personal use, demonstration, testing, research or scientific use etc. shall comply with the Standard Operating Procedure issued under Central Motor Vehicles (Eleventh Amendment) Rules, 2018 and notified vide GSR 870(E) dated 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways.

**Effect of the notification**: Registration of vehicles imported by the vehicle manufactures or through their authorized representatives in India or by the organization / citizen for personal

use, demonstration, testing, research or scientific use etc. shall comply with the Central Motor Vehicles (Eleventh Amendment) Rules, 2018.
