



March 2019 core infra grows at 4.7%

The core infrastructure grows at 4.7% in March 2019 as against 2.2% in February 2019. The combined Index of Eight Core Industries stood at 145.0 in March, 2019, which was 4.7% higher as compared to the index of March, 2018. Its cumulative growth during April to March, 2018-19 was 4.3%.

In cumulative terms, core infrastructure industries registered a growth of 4.3% during April-March 2018-19 as against the same 4.3% during April-March 2017-18.


