India is the world's third-largest energy consuming country, thanks to rising incomes and improving standards of living. As India recovers from a Covid-induced slump in 2020, it is re-entering a very dynamic period in its energy development. India's oil demand in total primary energy is projected to increase from 233 Million ton of oil equivalent (Mtoe) in 2018 to 305 Mtoe in 2025, as per the World Energy Outlook, published by International Energy Agency. India's growing energy needs will also make it more reliant on fossil fuel imports.

Government has taken several steps to enhance exploration & production of oil and gas, give thrust on demand substitution, promote energy efficiency and conservation, capitalize untapped potential on biofuels and alternative fuels/renewables in order to reduce imports of crude oil. These include a series of initiatives such as Policy for Relaxations, Extensions and Clarifications under Production Sharing Contract (PSC) regime for early monetization of hydrocarbon discoveries, Discovered Small Field Policy, Hydrocarbon Exploration and Licensing Policy.

Against this backdrop, PHD Chamber is organizing a **"National Refining** & Petrochemical Conclave 2021" on 14th September 2021, at 11.00 A.M. The objective of this webinar is to bring together the different stakeholders and discuss the future of refineries, deep water operations, Ease of doing business and the opportunities in India.
