Background



The Hon'ble Prime Minister Launched Gati-Shakti – National Master Plan with the INR 100 trillion for multi-modal connectivity to economic zones in the country. Gati Shakti – National Master Plan aims to integrate Infrastructure schemes of different Ministries like Bharatmala, Sagarmala, Inland Waterways, Dry / Land Ports, Railways, Roads & Highways, Aviation, etc and setting up new Economic Zones, Industrial / Agri / Pharma parks.

A national infrastructure master plan, Gati shakti plans to envisage a centralized portal to unite the infrastructural

initiatives planned and initiated by as many as 16 central ministries and departments

Last mile connectivity is to be prioritized while developing various economic zones and industrial parks and clusters, to make Indian businesses more competitive, with a reduced logistic cost along with the vision of providing Jobs opportunities to aspiring youth of the country.

An integral part of PMs' Aatmanirbhar Bharat vision, the master plan aims to lend more power and speed to projects under the \$1.5-trillion National Infrastructure Pipeline and accelerate the nation's goal of achieving a \$5-trillion economy, especially in wake of the recent economic impacts caused due to the coronavirus pandemic.
