ir travel is set to change greatly and with it so will airports and their infrastructure and services. India has become the third largest Domestic Aviation Market in the world and is also expected to become the third largest Air Passenger Market by 2024. The number of airplanes are expected to reach 1,100 planes by 2027.



India's passenger traffic stood at 341.05 million in FY'20. Aircraft movement grew at a CAGR of 9.56% from 1.60 million in FY16 to 2.59 million in FY20.

Having 91 international carriers comprising of 5 Indian and 86 foreign carriers ensure that India is well connected with most major countries. At present there are 52 Directorate General of Civil Aviation approved AME training Institutes in India.

India's aviation industry is expected to witness Rs. 35,000 crore (US\$ 4.99 billion) investment in the next four years. The Indian Government is planning to invest US\$ 1.83 billion for development of airport infrastructure along with aviation navigation services by 2026. India has envisaged increasing the number of operational airports from 190 to 200 by FY40.
