

## CPI inflation softens to 5.88% in November 2022

According to The National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), the CPI inflation softened to 5.88% (prov.) in November 2022 as compared to the 6.77% (final) in October 2022. The CPI inflation for rural and urban for the month of November 2022 is 6.1% and 5.6% respectively.

All India Inflation rates (on point to point basis i.e. current month over same month of last year, i.e. November 2022 over November 2021), based on General Indices and CFPIs are given as follows:

The Price data are collected from selected 1114 urban Markets and 1181 villages covering all States/UTs through personal visits by field staff of Field Operations Division of NSO, MoSPI on a weekly roster. During the month of November 2022, NSO collected prices from 99.8% villages and 98.3% urban Markets while the Market-wise prices reported therein were 90.6% for rural and 92.5% for urban.
