## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In today's globalized era Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) has emerged as one of the most feasible alternate economical and environment friendly fossil fuel for the gas-based economy. 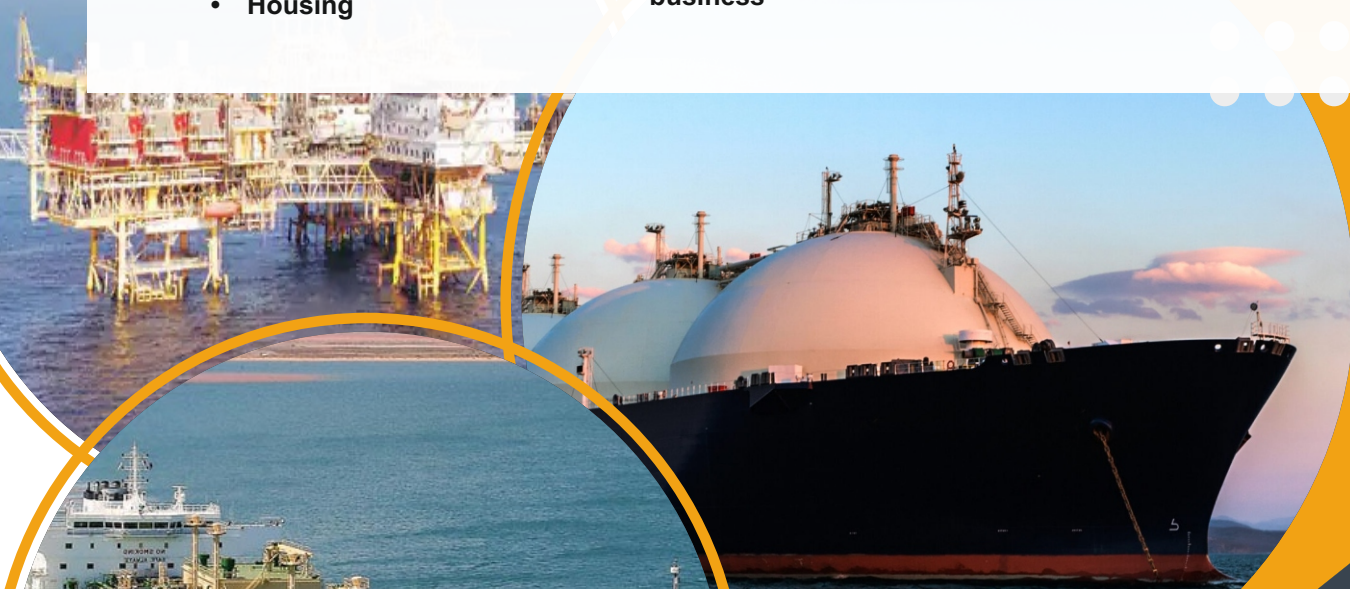
