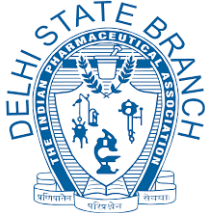

BACKGROUND:

The size of the Indian medical devices market is estimated at Rs. 90,000 crore (US\$ 11 billion) in 2022 and is expected to grow to US\$ 50 billion by 2030 with a CAGR of 16.4%.

The Indian medical device market share in the global market is estimated to be 1.65% and Market size of India pharmaceuticals industry is expected to reach US\$ 65 billion by 2024, and ~US\$ 130 billion by 2030.

The healthcare and medical device sectors in India have grown significantly in the last decade. A wide range of medical devices, from consumables to implantable medical devices, are produced in India and India is the largest provider of generic drugs globally and is known for its affordable vaccines and generic medications. The Indian Pharmaceutical industry is currently ranked third in pharmaceutical production by volume after evolving over time into a thriving industry growing at a CAGR of 9.43% since the past nine years.
