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

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Government & its big guns

N\$12.8-B OR ALMOST HALF OF THE NAMIBIAN GOVERNMENT'S N\$26.7-B BUDGET FOR ITS ADMINISTRATIVE CLUSTER IN 2024/25 IS FOR INTEREST PAYMENTS ON NATIONAL DEBT AND EXCEEDS THE FUNDING AVAILABLE TO EACH OF THE REMAINING ECONOMIC, EDUCATION, HEALTH AND WELFARE CLUSTERS. ADD TO THAT THE N\$16.7-B ENJOYED BY THE SECURITY APPARATUS, THE TWO CENTRAL CLUSTERS HAVE A COMBINED N\$43.4-B WITH A 45% SHARE OF THE RECORD N\$100-B TOTAL BUDGET - PAGE 2

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The 8% increase to the central government's salary bill to N\$35.4-b in 2024/25 – excluding state-owned entities – takes it to an historical high.

The Namibian government's N\$43.4-b operational and development budget for its administrative and security clusters in 2024/25 accounts for 45% of the N\$100-b record total, dwarfing the funds available to each of the remaining economic, education, health and welfare clusters which together account for the remaining 55%.

And almost half or N\$21.8-b of the bureaucracy's N\$26.7-b allocation is for interest payments on national debt that has swollen more than seven-fold over the past twelve years, while expenditure on the bureaucracy's wages has almost doubled to N\$35.4-b over the same period.

No wonder the administrative cluster consumes the biggest, 27.57% share of 2024/25's N\$97-b national budget, with the N\$22-b set aside for servicing debt and guarantees to state-owned entities accounting for 82.4% of the cluster's N\$26.7-b ceiling for operational and development expenditure.

And with a budget of N\$16.7-b, the security cluster accounts for over 17% of the total.

As we noted earlier in our procurement review of 2024/25's national budget (*Bulletin 1533*), with this year's general elections in November around the corner, the central government has tabled an expansive, record N\$100.1-b national budget for 2024/25, N\$44.3-b of which targets the poor and the youth who comprise over half the population and are key voting constituencies for the ruling Swapo party.

But this comes at the cost of a record N\$12.8-b to be spent on servicing government debt, which is 35% more than the N\$12.67-b set aside for development projects – including the N\$3.2-b foreign loans and grants.

The country's youth as well as those living under relative poverty each comprise about half of the population, so their votes count for a lot - which explains the propitious generosity of increased social welfare spending after years of neglect, together with generous allocations targeting the youth - all under the banner of 'caring for the Namibian child', as this year's national budget is themed.

According to the Bertelsmann Stiftung's 2024 Country Report on Namibia, expenditure on public sector salaries "is unsustainable and restricts the government's ability to make necessary investments in the economy", while the government's borrowing strategy results "in a worrisome accumulation of state debt" that "further diminishes the incentives for economic recovery".

Not the biggest development budget

As we also noted earlier (*Bulletin 1533*), the astronomical 46% increase in this year's domestically-financed development budget to N\$9.47-b outstrips the global budget's 11.6% increment as well as the 8% increase to the central government's salary bill to N\$35.4-b for 2024/25 – excluding state-owned entities – all at historical highs.

But this year's development budget is below 2025/16's actual N\$9.8-b development expenditure when it accounted for over 15% of overall expenditure, compared to this year's 9.77%.

This year's development budget also encompasses a 42.45% increase in construction to N\$3.2-b from last year's revised N\$2.2-b, but is less than 2022/23's N\$3.4-b actual expenditure on construction.

This year's domestically-financed development budget is the second-highest ever since 2015/16's N\$9.8-b. But the allocation for construction - all of which forms part of the development budget - has been superceded in nine previous years over the past eleven since 2013/14 and is bigger than those of only two earlier years – N\$2.78-b actual expenditure in 2021/22 and 2023/24's N\$2.2-b revised expenditure.

The N\$9.47-b development budget for 2024/25 is bolstered by N\$3.2-b foreign loans and grants, raising it to N\$12.67-b, compared to last year when N\$6.486-b domestic development expenditure was supplemented by N\$2-b in foreign loans and grants – both years less than 2022/23's N\$2.7-b.

Wages, investment and governance

According to the Bertelsmann Stiftung's 2024 Country Report on Namibia, more than 40% of the budget is allocated to current expenditure, primarily for public sector salaries.

Government and

In response to fiscal constraints that have emerged since 2016, the government has adopted a borrowing strategy, "resulting in a worrisome accumulation of state debt. This debt burden further diminishes the incentives for economic recovery".

In addition, the state budget is formulated "with little transparency and minimal consultation with non-governmental parties", while positions in government and senior public service levels "continue to be filled based on criteria other than professional competence, including considerations of ethnicity and political loyalty".

On procurement, the report says: "While stricter tender rules have been established, adherence to them is inconsistent. Exceptions are granted and sometimes abused, leading to the allocation of public funds to bidders who may not offer the best value for money, or any value at all."

Critical reports from the office of the auditor-general tend to be disregarded and appear to have little influence on improving practices (<https://bti-project.org>).

Key historical indicators

This year's 9% increase in debt servicing costs from N\$11.765-b in revised expenditure in 2023/24 to N\$12.8-b compares to the:

- * 11.6% growth in the overall budget from last year's revised N\$86.8-b expenditure to N\$97-b – excluding foreign loans;
- * 8% increase in central government personnel expenditure from 2034/24's revised N\$32.8-b to N\$35.437-b;
- * 22% increase in the procurement ceiling from last year's revised N\$11-b to N\$13.5-b;
- * 46% increase in development expenditure from last year's revised N\$6.486-b to N\$9.47.

In nominal terms, over the past twelve years between 2013/14 and 2024/25:

- * debt servicing costs have increased from N\$1.8-b by 711% to N\$12.8-b or 59.26% averaged annually;
- * overall budget expenditure has increased from N\$46.85-b by 207% to N\$97-b – 17.5% averaged annually;
- * personnel expenditure has increased from N\$18-b by 197.76% to N\$35.4-b – 16.48% averaged annually;
- * procurement spending has increased from

N\$9-b by 150% to N\$13.5-b – 12.5% averaged annually;

- * development expenditure has increased from N\$7.45-b by 127% to N\$9.47-b – 10.6% averaged annually.

As a share of overall budget expenditure over the past twelve years between 2013/14 and 2023/24:

- * debt servicing costs have more than trebled from 3.8% to 13.24%;
- * personnel expenditure has actually declined from 38.2% to almost 36.5%;
- * procurement spending has fallen from 19% to 14%;
- * development expenditure has more than halved from 16% to 9.77%.

Historical growth in costs of servicing debt

Over the past twelve years since 2013/14, the increase in the cost of servicing central government debt has generally outstripped the growth in the overall budget and in domestically-financed development expenditure.

- * Debt servicing costs increased by 40% from N\$1.796-b or 3.8% of N\$46.8-b total expenditure in 2013/14 to N\$2.5-b in 2014/15 or 4.27% of N\$58.85-b total expenditure.
- * This was followed by a mild 4.3% increment to N\$2.6-b in 2015/16 – a marginally lower 4.06% of the N\$64.6-b total budget.
- * The cost of servicing government debt then leapt suddenly by 64.36% to N\$4.3-b in 2016/17, consuming 6.95% of that year's N\$62-b overall budget.
- * It grew by a further 25.9% to N\$5.4-b or 8.3% of the total budget in 2017/18.
- * The following year it rose by a further 10.68% to N\$6-b or 9.2% of 2018/19's N\$65.2-b total budget.
- * Growth in debt servicing costs then rose a further 14.56% to N\$6.885-b in 2019/20 or 10.2% of the N\$67.4-b budget total.
- * In 2020/21 the cost of debt servicing escalated 5.89% to N\$7.3-b or 10% of 2020/21's N\$72.2-b record budget total.

- * In 2021/22, borrowing costs increased 6.1% to N\$7.7-b, accounting for 11% of N\$70.3-b total budget expenditure.
- * In 2022/23, interest payments increased by 22% to N\$9.466-b, consuming 12.7% of N\$74.5-b overall expenditure.
- * In terms of 2023/24's revised expenditure, N\$11.765-b debt servicing costs were 24.3% more, accounting for 13.55% of the N\$86.8-b total budget expenditure – the highest to date.
- * This year's N\$12.8-b voted for servicing debt is only 9% more, consuming 13.24% of the N\$97-b total budget, domestically financed. (See accompanying table.)

Pot belly of the remuneration beast

In time for general elections at the end of this year, central government personnel expenditure has been increased by 8% to N\$35.4-b in 2024/25 from last year's revised N\$32.8-b – the biggest year-on-year increase since 2017/18's 9% increase to N\$29-b.

Despite this, the bureaucracy's wage bill consumes 36.56% of the N\$97-b budget total this year – slightly less than 2023/24's 37.77% of N\$86.8-b revised expenditure total.

Compared to the seven-fold increase in central government debt servicing costs from N\$1.8-b in 2013/14 to this year's N\$12.8-b, personnel expenditure has almost doubled from N\$18-b N\$35.4-b.

Over these past twelve years:

- * the central government wage bill – excluding state-owned entities - grew 21% from N\$17.9-b in 2013/14 to N\$21.66-b the following year, its share of the total budget actually falling from 38% of N\$46.8-b to 36.8% of N\$58.8-b.
- * It then grew by 10.6% to N\$23.96-b in 2015/16 when it consumed 37% of the N\$64.6-b budget total.
- * In 2016/17 it rose by 11.68% to N\$26.75-b or 43% of N\$62-b total expenditure.
- * This was followed by a 9% increase to N\$29.2-b in 2017/18 or 44.65% of the N\$65.3-b budget total.
- * In 2018/19 personnel expenditure rose by a marginal 0.75% to N\$29.4-b or 45% of the N\$65.2-b budget total.
- * The following year saw an even lower 0.6% increase to N\$29.57-b in 2019/20 or 43.87% of the N\$67.4-b total budget.
- * It grew by only 0.7% in 2020/21 to N\$29.6-b, consuming 41% the N\$72-b budget.
- * After three years of moderate growth below 1% annually, the cost of government personnel expenditure increased in 2021/22 by 2.1% to N\$30.2-b, accounting for 43% of the budget total (N\$70.3-b).
- * The N\$31.47-b wage bill in 2022/23 represented a 4.18% increase over the previous year, consuming a slightly lowered 42.2% of N\$74.5-b

actual total budget expenditure.

- * Last year's increase remained roughly constant at 4.2%, reaching N\$32.8-b – a lower 37.77% of N\$86.8-b revised overall expenditure.
- * This year's 8.05% higher central government remuneration budget to N\$35.4-b is almost double last year's 4.2% increment over the previous year, but consuming a lowered 36.56% of the budget total, compared to last year's 37.77%.

A history of mediocre budget increases

Contrasted with these exorbitant increases in personnel expenditure and debt servicing costs, the growth in central government's overall budget over the past twelve years has far been less impressive, increasing from N\$46.85-b in 2013/14 to N\$97-b in 2024/25.

This 207% increase is overshadowed by the 711% growth in debt servicing costs from N\$1.8-b twelve years ago N\$12.8-b, but is slightly ahead of the 197.76% increase in personnel expenditure from N\$18-b in 2013/14 to this year's N\$35.4-b.

But over these past twelve years, there have been three year-on-year contractions in the total budget, with nine annual increases, compared to no annual declines in civil servants remuneration or interest payments on debt:

- * Total central government expenditure grew by 25.6% from N\$46.85-b in 2013/14 to N\$58.85-b the following year; and
- * by 9.8% to N\$64.6-b in 2015/16; before
- * declining by 3.96% to N\$62-b in 2016/17 – the sharpest fall to date, before;
- * increasing by 5.3% to N\$65.3-b in 2017/18;
- * again falling by 0.13% to N\$65.2-b the following year;
- * then rising by 3.3% to N\$67.4-b in 2019/20;
- * and increasing by 6.86% to N\$72-b in 2020/21;
- * before falling by 2.4% to 2021/22's N\$70.3-b – the second-biggest decline to date.
- * Total actual budget expenditure increased by 6% to N\$74.5-b in 2022/23, followed by 2023/24's 16.5% growth to N\$86.8-b revised spending – only the second double-digit increase in twelve years but well short of 2014/15's record 25.6% increment.

Comparing clusters

In its usual first place, the administrative cluster's N\$26.7-b operational and development budget for 2024/25 is the biggest out of five clusters, with a 27.57% share of the N\$97-b total, following an 8.58% or N\$2.1-b increase over last year's revised N\$24.6-b expenditure when it enjoyed slightly bigger 28.3% share of the N\$486.8-b total.

Its 8.58% increase this year is below the 11.6% increase in the total budget and less than a third of last year's 27% or N\$5.2-b increase on 2022/23's actual N\$19.378-b expenditure, which had been well above the 16.5% increase in overall expenditure.

The administrative cluster enjoyed a 26% share of 2022/23's total N\$74.5-b operational and development expenditure – lower than the following two years.

- * With N\$23.8-b voted for operational and development expenditure in 2024/25, the education cluster again

The Defence Vote's N\$6.74-b allocation accounting for 40.4% of the N\$16.686-b security cluster total in 2024/25 is second behind Home Affairs, Immigration, Safety & Security's N\$7.4-b or 44.4%.

lies in second place, accounting for 24.56% of the N\$97-b domestically-financed budget, following a 10.3% or N\$2.2-b increase over last year's revised N\$21.58-b expenditure, when it enjoyed a similar 24.85% share of the total.

The 10.33% increase on last year is below the 11.6% increase in the total budget, as was the case last year when its 13.68% or N\$2.6-b increase was lower than the 16.5% higher overall revised expenditure.

It also ranked second behind the administrative cluster in 2022/23, when its N\$18.98-b actual expenditure accounted for a higher 25.47% of the total.

In contrast to the administrative cluster's increasing share of overall expenditure over the three years, the educational cluster's share has declined.

* Repeating its third place ranking, the health and welfare cluster has a N\$19.1-b operational and development budget in 2024/25, accounting for 19.7% of the N\$97-b total, following a 14.56% or N\$2.4-b increase over last year's revised N\$16.67-b revised expenditure when it enjoyed a marginally lower 19.2% share – but below 2022/23's 19.67% share with N\$14.66-b.

Although its 14.55% increase on last year is higher than the 11.6% increase in the total budget, the education cluster's 13.7% or N\$2-b increase last year on 2022/23's actual N\$14.66-b expenditure fell far short of the 16.5% increase in the total budget.

* The security cluster is again ranked fourth, its N\$16.686-b budget for 2024/25 being the second-smallest out of five clusters, accounting for 17.2% of the N\$97-b total, following the smallest, 8.5% or N\$1.3-b increase on last year's N\$15.377-b revised expenditure when it accounted for a marginally higher 17.7% share of the total.

This cluster's 8.5% increase on last year is well below the 11.6% increase in the total budget.

Its N\$15.377-b revised expenditure in 2023/24 had been an 8.4% or N\$1.2-b increase on the previous year's N\$14.185-b actual expenditure.

This is half the 16.5% increase in total expenditure in 2022/23 when it accounted for a significantly higher 19% share of the total – reflecting the

security cluster's declining share of total expenditure since 2022/23.

It is also noteworthy that since 2022/23, the security cluster's expenditure has been below that of the education and health/welfare clusters – a welcome reversal of earlier years.

* Again fifth and last, the economic cluster's N\$10.6-b overall expenditure ceiling excluding foreign loans in 2024/25 accounts for the smallest, 10.95% share of the N\$97-b total – despite its biggest, 23.58% increase of all clusters and more than double the total budget's 11.6% increment.

The economic cluster's N\$2-b increase on last year's revised N\$8.586-b expenditure when it accounted for 9.9% of the total was 17.28% or N\$1.26-b more than its N\$7.3-b actual expenditure in 2022/23 when it accounted for a similar 9.8% share of the total, despite its increase having been above the 16.5% higher overall revised expenditure.

Although the economic cluster's share of the overall budget is traditionally the smallest, its near-11% share of the total this year is significantly higher than last year's 9.89% and 2022/23's 9.82%, but it remains below that of the security cluster's 17.2% share in 2024/25, which has narrowed however, from last year when it was almost half the security cluster's 17.7% and in 2022/23 when it was less than half the security cluster's 19%.

The administrative cluster

According to finance and public enterprises minister lipumbu Shiimi, the administrative cluster does not account for the biggest share amongst five clusters, but the smallest, with N\$6.8-b or 7.8% of the 2024/25 budget "to support effective governance and efficient administration of public services".

This is because he does not include this year's N\$12.8-b debt repayment costs channeled through the finance ministry, which we locate within the administrative cluster since not all this ministry's expenditure carries economic content. Besides, debt servicing costs due not, strictly speaking, accrue to ac-

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Over the past twelve years between 2013/14 and 2024/25 debt servicing costs have increased 59.26% averaged annually and personnel expenditure 16.48%, compared to 17.5% annual growth in overall budget expenditure, 12.5% in procurement spending and only 10.6% in average annual development expenditure.

tivities in within the economic cluster. The Finance & Public Enterprises Vote's N\$20.96-b accounts for 78.44% of the administrative cluster's N\$26.7-b budget in 2024/25.

Shiimi also includes the Urban & Rural Development Vote in the administrative sector, which we group with the economic cluster.

According to Shiimi's February budget speech, the Ministry of Urban & Rural Development has increased by 37.6% to N\$2.6-b in 2024/25.

In addition to provisions for housing, this includes N\$250-m for the rollout of prepaid water and electricity meters in various local authorities as a long-term solution to their rising debt with NamPower and NamWater.

An additional N\$141-m has been allocated for the transformation of Aus and Lüderitz local authorities to improve services due to the growing population "driven by oil and gas exploration as well as green hydrogen activities in the region".

Other allocations highlighted by Shiimi are:

* N\$1.1-b to the Office of the Prime Minister, including provisions of N\$700-m for drought

relief. * N\$438-m to the Electoral Commission for voters registration and to undertake the Presidential and National Assembly elections towards the end of the year.

The security cluster

What Shiimi describes as the 'Public Safety Sector' receives N\$15.4-b of the budget in 2024/25 or 17.6% of the total excluding interest payments, which is the second-lowest amongst five clusters as was the case last year, according to our assessment.

* The Anti-Corruption Commission has been allocated N\$106-m, a 29.8% increase from the previous financial year, "to improve implementation capacity, particularly in area of combating anti-money laundering and financial crimes."

* Home Affairs, Immigration, Safety & Security's N\$7.4-b includes over N\$70-m for the roll-out electronic identification cards (e-IDs) "and ensure full coverage of civil registration through mass registration for national documents countrywide".

* The Judiciary has been allocated N\$445.5-m "to ensure speedy delivery of services", while the Justice Vote's

N\$674.3-m is 8.6% more than last year.

* Shiimi did not mention the Defence Vote's N\$6.74-b allocation that accounts for 40.4% of the N\$16.686-b security cluster total in second place behind Home Affairs, Immigration, Safety & Security's N\$7.4-b, with a 44.4% share.

N\$103-M KEETMANSHOOP VTC NEARS COMPLETION

31 MAY 2024

The N\$103-m Keetmanshoop Vocational Training Centre, funded through an African Development Bank loan should be completed by the end of August, after a twelve-month delay.

After the contract was awarded to Shanxi Construction & Investment in January 2022, a new sub-contractor, Ponoka Trading Enterprises, was appointed to finish the project, later last year when it was 64% complete.

Site project manager Archman Robert told deputy minister of Higher Education, Training & Innovation, Natalia /Goagoses during a recent site visit that the VTC will be handed over to the Namibia Training Authority after completion.

NTA Technical & Vocational Education & Training standards manager, Amon Haufiku, said the first intake of students was anticipated in January 2025.

The project includes four small workshops, an administration block, two classrooms, ablution facilities, a

guardhouse and student accommodation. The centre, with a capacity for 140 students, is located in the Noordhoek residential area on 3,000sqm of land that was bought from the Keetmanshoop municipality for N\$4.5-m (*New Era 21-May-24*).

Chinese firms dominated the 15 offers from N\$98.85-m to N\$117-m

The Ministry of Education, Arts & Culture confirmed the award of the tender Chinese firm Shanxi Construction & Investment Group Co Ltd for N\$103,029,012.43 on 06-Jan-22.

Tender W/ICB/MoEAC/AfDB/010-01/2021/22 called for the construction of the new VTC in Keetmanshoop, Phase 1B over a contract period of

18 months.

The works was funded through a N\$1.2-b loan from the AfDB under its Education & Training Quality Improvement Project (ETQIP).

Although the tender was issued by MEAC, bidding was evaluated under AfDB open international competitive bidding.

Fifteen offers from N\$98.85-m to N\$117-m were received, when the tender closed on 17-Aug-21, of which eleven were from Chinese contractors - one in joint venture with a Namibian. There was no margin of preference for local bidders, of which there were four.

The MEAC award notice provided no explanation why the seventh most expensive offer was successful or why Shanxi's price increased by N\$65,000,

after it bid N\$102,964,577.11 at the bid opening but announced as N\$103,029,012.43 for the award.

Construction of the bulk services and earthworks, awarded to NCCS Holding Investments (Pty) Ltd, were completed in December 2018.

Shanxi Construction Investment has been bidding in Namibia for large MEAC, Roads Authority, NamPower and NHE contracts, according to the *Tender Bulletin's* records.

Shanxi Jiantou Guohe Co. Ltd entered the Namibian market for the first time at the end of 2019, winning contracts for the renovation and construction of two new schools for the MEAC (report in *Tender Bulletin 1435*, 28-Jan-22 & tender details from *Bulletin 1404*).

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SOCIAL GRANTS JUNKET REFUELLED FOR N\$129-M

31 MAY 2024

Instead of processing tenders received for the cash payment of basic state grants and allowances to social grant beneficiaries, the Central Procurement Board on 11 April extended the existing contract to Epupa Investment Technology (Pty) Ltd for N\$27,300,000 after it had first been awarded multi-year tender M33-2/2016 from the former Tender Board of Namibia eight years ago.

The CPB approved a Request for 'Extension of Contract' under M33-2/2016 for rendering of services to the government for cash payments of basic state grants and allowances to beneficiaries, according to a notice on the CPB's website.

Although other tenders with extended contract periods indicate the period for which they have been extended, this is not indicated for the social grants contract.

According to information distributed during a press briefing by the CPB last week on 22-May, a three-month extension from 01-Sep-23 to 31-Jan-24 had been granted for N\$44.5-m, followed by another extension from 01-Feb-24 to 31-Jul-24 for N\$57-m.

This latest extension follows a new tender that should have closed on 28 March this year: NCS/ONB/CPBN-02/2023 for rendering services to the government to effect cash payment of basic state grants and allowances to beneficiaries of social grants for a period of five years.

On 22-May-24, CPB Chairperson Amon Ngavetene said the new tender was on hold because of the 100% Namibian ownership requirement. All bidders were being informed of any changes through clarifications so that they could make amendments if required, and the tender would not be re-advertised, he added.

The new tender is merely listed on the CPB website under the tab 'Bids under Evaluation', but has been put on hold, according to a CPB spokesperson who was asked to explain the absence of the bid opening report.

The CPB had issued the new tender on behalf of the Ministry of Gender Equality, Poverty Eradication & Social Welfare.

The closing date was extended from 15-Feb-24 and 22-Feb-24. A short version of the tender notice was advertised in *The Namibian* on 19-Jan-24 and in *New Era* and *The Namibian* on 21-Dec-23 – just before Christmas day.

The details, including a non-compulsory pre-bid meeting on 12-Jan-24 and the closing date, were only found on the CPB website on 02-Jan-24.

Politically-connected company clings to lucrative social grants contract worth N\$68.5-m five years ago

Tender Bulletin 1508 reported on

Central Procurement Board puts its new five-year tender for the distribution of social grants on hold and extends politically-connected Epupa Investech's contract from 2016 for another N\$84-m until July following last year's N\$44.5-m extension that lapsed in January – totaling N\$128.8-m between September 2023 until beyond July this year.

08-Sep-23 that the Central Procurement Board had approved an application by the Ministry of Gender Equality, Poverty Eradication & Social Welfare to extend its contract for the distribution of old age, disability and other social grants to the current contract holder, Epupa Investments Technology (Pty) Ltd.

Trading as Epupa Investech, the company was awarded the same five-year tender, M33-2/2016, for two consecutive terms, in addition to two extensions of one year each in 2011 and 2022, after which another three-month extension up to 30-Nov-23 was granted in July 2023. Since grant payments were not interrupted, this must have been extended again until April this year, although no such notice was posted on the CPB website under the 'Extensions' tab.

Epupa initially won the tender for the period 2011-2015. After the term ended, the ministry's procurement office extended the contract for another year in 2016. When the ministry invited the next round of bids Epupa Investments again landed the contract for 2017-2021.

The directors of Epupa Investments are Maurice Bishop Auala (son of Namibian Defence Force retired Brigadier James Vilho Auala), Naka Shimwino (son of mining magnate David Saul Shimwino), Esther Taapopi (daughter of former City of Windhoek CEO Niilo Taapopi), Mariam Hoveka as chairperson and her cousin Pangii Hoveka as well as Ngurimuje Tjirimuje.

According to earlier media reports, Epupa used to be owned by businessman David Shimwino, former Education PS Loini Katoma, Tyves Kuugongelwa (brother of prime minister Saara Kuugongelwa-Amadhila) and retired brigadier-general James Auala.

The firm's MD, Shalli Ben-Elungu explained that the 2016 contract extension was required because the ministry of Labour & Social Welfare changed to the Ministry of Poverty Eradication & Social Welfare. In 2021 the contract was extended because of the merger of the gender and poverty eradication ministries (*The Namibian 10-Jul-23; Tender Bulletin 1508*).

Last year, the Swapo website still listed Shalli Ben-Elungu as member of its Think Tank Cluster 218[sic]-2022 under **CLUSTER III: "INFRASTRUCTURE" AND SERVICES.**

The Namibian reported on 31-Aug-11, that an urgent High Court application was lodged against Epupa Investment Technology for failing to comply with a N\$13-m loan agreement with Peace Garden Transportation. This



was a year after Epupa had won the five-year tender for the distribution of the social state grants.

Only three months granted on one-year requested contract extension

On 13-Jul-23, the Central Procurement Board granted a contract extension for rendering services to effect cash payment of basic state grants and allowances to beneficiaries on behalf of the government to the MGEPEWS for tender M33-2/2016 for three months until 30-Nov-23.

Earlier, on 14-Feb-23, an application by the ministry to extend the contract for one year was only partially approved by the CPB, according to the CPB website listing of 'extensions'.

On 11-Aug-23, the CPB approved the ministry's request for "price adjustment and statutory price increase" without providing further details under the 'Price Increase' tab on its website.

Contract was worth N\$68.5-m in 2018/19 after UAG's 2010 and 2017 court challenges failed

Tender Bulletin 1224 reported on 13-Oct-17 that the United Africa Group had lost a court challenge to the Tender Board's award of the contract to administer cash payments for pensions and social grants to Epupa Investment Technology.

The Tender Board had disqualified United Security Services because their letter of good standing from the bank was in the name of the holding company, United Africa Group. The company also did not submit a social responsibility proposal, which was a requirement.

Judge Boas Usiku agreed with the Tender Board that the applicant could not argue convincingly that it had complied with all the conditions and specifications set out in the tender document, dismissing UAG's application with costs payable to the Tender Board and Epupa.

Previously, in Jun-11, UAG had also lost its legal challenge to the 2010 tender award to Epupa for a five-year period. UAG had handled the payments of state grants from 1999 to 2010 before it was awarded to Epupa for the first time.

Court papers at the time revealed that the former Ministry of Poverty Eradication & Social Welfare had budgeted N\$50-m for handling the state grant payments for the 2016/17 financial year, N\$66.8-m for 2017/18 and N\$68.5-m for 2018/19 (*New Era 21-Sep-17; The Namibian 22-Sep-17*).

Between 90,000 and 140,000 monthly payments must be delivered to beneficiaries in all regions. The number of payments may vary during the contract period but the minimum anticipated number of payments is 500,000.

The contract worth between N\$55-m and N\$180-m was restricted to previously disadvantaged Namibians, with stringent conditions including 'no collusion, no unauthorised contact with the Ministry or Tender Board officials, nor the offer of any inducement in order to secure the contract'. The successful contractor also had to make cash donations to three social projects in each region annually.

The government could have saved about N\$11-m, since UAG's bid was about 10% cheaper than Epupa's (*Tender Bulletin 1508, 1224 & 1184*).

Manages over N\$15-b in financial assets

According to its website, Epupa has managed over N\$15-b in financial assets over the past ten years and has dispensed monthly cash payments under the Basic State Grants and Allowances scheme on behalf of the Namibian government to more than 237,000 registered beneficiaries in all fourteen regions.

"Epupa set up an efficient Information Communications Technology (ICT) network to reach the entire country without compromising the integrity of information (data), while dealing with the systematic risks of handling enormous amounts of funds monthly.

"Epupa has developed fool proof cash handling procedures that are constantly being monitored to ensure any deficiencies are identified and corrected immediately."

The registration of beneficiaries, life certification, verification, data updates and the issuance of smart cards "are the starting premise in such a process and Epupa can confidently claim local superiority in these spheres".

Operating "one of the largest payment information systems networks in Namibia", the company "is a leading supplier of technological solution, including the most remote areas of Namibia".

Epupa is also engaged in data systems development and smart card production for government ministries (<https://www.epupainvestech.com>).
