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

NamWater has awarded a tender for the construction of the Outapi water treatment works extension and upgrade to China Jiangxi International in joint venture with Homefin Properties for N\$112-m, two months after the same partnership landed a N\$91-m contract for the construction of Ondangwa – Oshali water pipeline.

The Outapi water treatment construction contract was awarded directly by NamWater in May, following the award in February of the Ondangwa – Oshali water pipeline construction project by the Central Procurement Board.

Since both projects are above NamWater's N\$30-m threshold for direct procurement, the non-involvement of the CPB in the Outapi water treatment tender indicates the water utility was granted an exemption from the finance ministry to administer it directly.

Tender W/ONB/NW-014/2024 for the construction of the Outapi water treatment works extension and upgrade closed 19-Mar-24 with five offers from N\$122-m to N\$162-m involving seven Chinese companies, as published in *Bulletin 1540*.

The tender was reserved for Namibian registered entities and advertised in *The Namibian* on 19-Jan-24 and listed in *Bulletin 1524*.

According to an executive summary notice posted on the water utility's website, this tender was awarded on 15-May-24 to the China Jiangxi International / Homefin Properties joint venture for N\$112,094,182.20 excluding VAT and contingencies. Their price at the bid opening was N\$123,184,517.06.

The only other bidder not disqualified also included a Chinese contractor:

* Unik Construction Engineering Namibia / CK Heydt Civils JV = N\$127,815,866.31.

All three the remaining non-compliant tenderers also all involved Chinese firms in joint venture with local contractors. Their VAT-exclusive prices in ascending order were:

* West Trading / New Era Investment / CCCC Origin Water Construction Group [not found on BIPA - no TAX, SSC nor AA] JV = N\$121,787,819.44 - no clear detailed information given on various forms under Volume 1.2; did not submit any of the catalogues "nor did they indicate it anywhere else";

* RK Investment / China Jiangsu International Economic & Technical Cooperation Group [no AA] / Tianjin Pipeline Engineering Group [not found on BIPA] - no TAX, SSC or AA JV = N\$142,458,455.98 - historical contract non-performance not fully completed (bidder submitted an amended form different from the one issued in the bidding documents, where the section regarding pending litigation is removed); no information provided for various equipment such as chlorine dosing equipment;

* Adaptive Building Land Construction / China State Construction Engineering Corporation JV = N\$162,380,664.10 - page 68 of BOQ not initiated.

Ondangwa – Oshali water pipeline

As reported in *Bulletin 1537* (19 April - 'China Jiangxi's N\$91-m splash'), the Central Procurement Board confirmed the award of the N\$91-m contract for the Ondangwa – Oshali water pipeline to the same Chinese firm and its local

partner after an order by the Review Panel to reconsider – but provided no explanation for the why the review was requested or the CPB's decision to stick with its original decision.

The CPB confirmed its award of the contract for the Ondangwa - Omutsegwomine water pipeline replacement to China Jiangxi International / Homefin Properties joint venture for N\$91,110,479.61 including VAT.

This Notice of Award dated 14-Feb-24 followed a reconsideration order by the Review Panel dated 08-Feb-24 after the initial award in Dec-23.

No further information could be found on the CPB website or under Review Panel decisions on the finance ministry's website to clarify the Review Panel order.

The successful bidder announced in February was the same as stated in the earlier CPB award notice dated 21-Nov-23 - the China Jiangxi International / Homefin Properties JV (report in *Bulletin 1522*, 15-Dec-23).

Tender W/RB/CPBN-01/2023 for the construction of the Ondangwa - Omutsegwomine water pipeline replacement and ancillary works: Phase

1 (Ondangwa - Oshali section) was inexplicably issued under 'Restricted Bidding' and closed 15-Aug-23 with 13 offers from N\$78-m to N\$105-m, including five Chinese firms, as published in *Bulletin 1520*.

The CPB Procurement Management Unit had re-issued this tender on behalf of NamWater as 'Restricted Bidding' after the 'Open Advertised Bidding' tender W/OAB/CPBN-10/2022 closing 07-Feb-23 was cancelled by the CPB on 04-Jul-23.

Only 13 of the 18 tenderers from the ONB tender submitted offers in the second round.

In addition to the successful joint venture, only one other bidder was found to be responsive under the RB tender:

* Otesa Civil Engineering, Makalani Engineering & JNJ Trading JV = N\$145,543,933.14 - ranked 2nd.

The reasons for rejecting the remaining bidders included not having signed certain pages or missing documents in their submissions, while the Zhong Mei & Luka joint venture was rejected because Zhong Mei's NamRA good standing certificate had

Besides these two tenders, Chinese firms have been awarded two of three water infrastructure contracts worth N\$826-m that are being funded through AfDB loans totaling N\$1.8-b – in addition to further projects financed by the Namibian government.

Water tenders virtually an all-Chinese affair

The award of the Ondangwa – Oshali pipeline contract, which is financed by the Namibian government, follows the award in January by the African Development Bank of NamWater's contract for the Rundu Water Purification Plant to China Civil Engineering for N\$577.8-m, hot on the heels of the N\$248.3-m Ohangwena Wellfield contract awarded to Unik Construction, while its contract for the Oshakati Water Treatment Plant has yet to be announced but seems destined to go to another Chinese firm.

This would give Chinese contractors a full house on all three these water infrastructure tenders in northern Namibia, worth a combined N\$1.485-b – all funded through a N\$1.8-b AfDB loan to Namibia.

Stringent technical and financial criteria on these three water projects ruled out any participation by Namibian contractors on their own, sparking protests from the Construction Industries

Federation who last year called for the cancellation of the tenders and their re-issue in smaller lots (*Bulletin 1523*).

Bidders on the three AfDB-funded water tenders had to have average annual construction turnovers of at least US\$38-m (N\$740-m) over the past five years.

In addition, they had to prove construction experience the past fifteen years and must have been involved in the completion of two similar projects since the beginning of 2010 worth US\$27-m (N\$526-m) and with a combined capacity of at least 25 million litres.

The N\$659-m Oshakati Purification Plant tender

Tender W/OIB/NW-003/2024 for the construction of the Oshakati Purification Plant was one of three construction tenders in northern Namibia funded by the AfDB's loan for the Namibia Water Sector Support Program that closed at NamWater's head office in Windhoek on 11-Sep-23. The AfDB's cost estimate for this project is N\$659-m and has not been publicly awarded.

The other two tenders – both awarded to Chinese contractors – are:

* W/OIB/NW-001/2024: Construction contract for the Rundu Purification Plant and associated infrastructure. AfDB's cost estimate is N\$790,021,164. VAT-exclusive prices for nine tenderers including eleven Chinese and two South African contractors were published in *Bulletin 1510*.

* W/OIB/NW-002/2024: Construction contract for the Ohangwena II Wellfield Water Supply Schemes (WSS). AfDB's cost estimate is N\$289-m. VAT-exclusive prices of nine tenders involving ten Chinese contractors were also published in *Bulletin 1510*.

Controversially, the award of the Oshakati purification plant tender has not been made public and has been reissued.

This is after *The Namibian* reported on 14-Feb-24 that NamWater had decided to award this tender above the

N\$659-m cost estimate to a Chinese company for N\$935-m - N\$447-m more expensive than one of the other bids.

According to documents reviewed by *The Namibian*, NamWater awarded this tender to Shaanxi Construction Engineering Group for N\$936-m, although its bid was N\$790-m.

According to the newspaper's report, a letter to NamWater chief executive Abraham Nehemia dated 21 December 2023 from the AfDB shows that Shaanxi Construction Engineering Group was established in 1998 but did not list any projects prior to 2010.

"This is against the bank's guidance as a request for such information will not change the substance of the bid, but this is to establish the qualification of the bidder. The bank insists that such information can be obtained to ascertain whether the bidder has such historical information. Requesting clarification on historical information does not change the substance of the bid," the bank said in its letter.

Nehemia told *The Namibian* in response that all that had been done to date was a notification of the intention to award.

At that stage (14-Feb-24) the NamWater official said they were in a 10-day standstill period after which a public notification of the executive summary of evaluation report would be published (*The Namibian* 14-Feb-24).

At the time of going to print this week (11 July 2024), this public notification has still not been published – either by the AfDB or NamWater.

* Restricted bidding tender W/WRB/NW-002/2024 for the design, manufacture, supply, installation and commissioning of the Shavura and Kayengona filtration plant in Kavango East was awarded to Aqua Services & Engineering for N\$4.69-m on 28-Aug-23 – closing date not disclosed (*Bulletin 1511*);

* W/ONB/NW-005/2024 for the replacement of Collector 1 section - Schwarzkuppe - Swakopmund pipeline of Collector 2 was awarded to CK Heydt Civils / Unik Construction Engineering Namibia JV for N\$59.6-m on 02-Aug-23 after closing 20-Jun-23 with 11 offers, including four Chinese contractors, with the only other responsive bidder being Zhong Mei Engineering Group / Luka Roads Rails Civils JV (*Bulletin 1521*);

* W/ONB/NW-006/2024 for the replacement of pipeline from Omdel to Henties Bay was awarded to Strydo Construction for N\$15.317-m on 04-Oct-23 after closing 20-Jun-23 with no Chinese bidders (*Bulletin 1521*);

* W/ONB/NW-001/2024 for the construction of new pipelines and a 500m³ reservoir at Aroab was awarded to JDN Civil Engineering / Tiananmen Investment JV for N\$11.162-m on 13-Oct-23 after closing 08-Aug-23 with no other Chinese bidders involved (*Bulletin 1521*).

It is noteworthy that these relatively smaller locally-funded contracts did not attract much interest from Chinese contractors.

northern water supply system. The project includes the construction of a 203km pipeline as well as four boreholes at Oshandi and Eenhana.

The Ohangwena Climate Resilient Water Supply Project seeks to establish numerous smaller decentralised abstraction systems, treatment and distribution across the project area.

It also includes the construction of the Omundaungilo - Omutsegwonime bulk pipeline.

This component adds a third primary source, the Tsumbe Karst Aquifer to the integrated water supply system, according to Schlettwein.

In the past the Oshakati purification plant and the Kunene River have been the only primary sources of fresh water supplying several schemes in the Ohangwena Region with drinking water (*New Era, The Namibian 02-Jul-24*).

N\$120-M WATER INFRASTRUCTURE STOLEN IN NORTHERN NAMIBIA

12 JULY 2024

At a groundbreaking ceremony for two bulk water projects in northern Namibia late in June, Agriculture, Water & Land Reform minister Calle Schlettwein disclosed that water pumps and solar panels worth N\$120-m were stolen in 2023 alone. Borehole equipment such as power supply, water tanks, pumps and some distribution lines were lost in the process.

As a result, "the communities that were served with clean, reliable water lost that existential service", he said. The minister described the situation as intolerable and urged communities to look after their infrastructure, while traditional authorities, regional and local authorities should join hands to prevent such crimes and bring the culprits to book.

The two water projects serve the Oshana, Oshikoto and Ohangwena regions.

N\$91-m Ondangwa - Omutsegwonime pipeline

During the groundbreaking ceremony for Phase 1 of the Ondangwa - Omutsegwonime pipeline replacement project on 28 June, Schlettwein pointed out that the project aimed at improving water supply to meet increasing demand resulting from population growth and increased economic activities in the Oshana and Oshikoto regions.

Water pumps, solar panels and borehole equipment including power supply, water tanks, pumps and distribution lines worth N\$120-m were stolen in 2023 alone, Agriculture, Water & Land Reform minister Calle Schlettwein has disclosed.

Funded by NamWater, the bulk water supply scheme conveys potable water over 110km, servicing urban centres and rural areas.

NamWater's head of public relations and corporate communications, Lot Ndamanomhata, admitted that current infrastructure is plagued with frequent pipe bursts and supply interruptions.

Phase 1 of the pipeline replacement project covers the 17km from Ondangwa to Oshali and should be completed within twelve months. The N\$91-m contract was awarded to a joint venture between China Jiangxi International and Homefin Properties (see separate report in this edition).

The Ondangwa - Omutsegwonime bulk water supply scheme, known as the South East Scheme, provides essential water resources to the Oshana and Oshikoto regions.

The 110km pipeline conveys potable water from Ondangwa, through Omuthiya to Omutsegwonime Village with various branch lines, such as Onethindi - Onandjokwe, Onathingene - Onayena, Okatope - Okankolo, Okatope - Omuntele and several bulk feeder lines.

In addition to the primary pump station at Ondangwa, several booster pump stations are located at Oshale, Okatope and Omuthiya to ensure effective distribution of water across the extensive network.

N\$250-m Ohangwena II Wellfield Project

Another groundbreaking ceremony took place on 29 June for the N\$250-m Ohangwena II Wellfield Project, which is co-financed by the African Development Bank, which provided a N\$1.8-b loan for various projects, including the Ohangwena II Wellfield, new purification plants at Oshakati and Rundu and other projects, for which the Namibian government contributed a further N\$1.5-b.

The contract for the Ohangwena II Wellfield project was awarded to controversial Chinese firm Unik Construction for N\$248.3-m (see separate report in this edition).

Its CEO, A Nehemia, notified bidders of the cancellation of the consultancy tender for the new desalination plant in the Erongo Region, according to

a notice on the water utility's website. The bidding process was cancelled with immediate effect in line with Section 54(1)(e) of the Public Procurement Act 15 of 2015, which provides for the cancellation when "an irregularity occurred that warrants the cancellation of the bidding process". Tender SC/RP/NW-008/2024 called

for the provision of geo-technical and geological services associated with the design of the proposed new desalination plant in the Erongo Region.

The tender had closed on 16-Nov-23 but no bid opening register or further details could be found on the NamWater website.

The tender was posted only on its

website on 02-Nov-24 as SC/RP/NW-007/2024 and listed in *Bulletin 1516*.

CHINA'S SWAKOP URANIUM TO PARTNER IN NAM'S SECOND DESALINATION PLANT

12 JULY 2024

The construction of Namibia's second desalination plant at Henties Bay with an estimated capacity of 20 million cubic metres should start in January next year, according to the minister of Agriculture, Water & Land Reform, Calle Schlettwein.

During the launch of the Henties Bay Land Development Conference from 26 to 29 June, Schlettwein said fresh desalinated water was expected to be available from this plant in early 2027 if things go according to plan.

The other desalination facility in the Erongo Region is the Orano Desalination Plant at Wlotzkasbaken.

The Erongo Region draws water through abstraction from two ground water aquifers, the Omaruru Delta at Henties Bay and the Kuiseb Delta near Walvis Bay. Together with Orano, these have reached their limit of sustainable supply, which currently stands at about 30 million m³ annually.

"Your ambitious development plans, as well as those of Walvis Bay and Swakopmund, increased mining activities and industrial demand and agriculture and food production have increased the projected demand beyond what the sources can deliver," the minister said.

The Maritime Industrial Estate and Dry Zone envisaged for Henties Bay include a modular green crude refinery and bio-oil refinery. The plans for a natural gas liquefaction and re-gasification plant and a chemical fertilizer plant further underscore Namibia's commitment to harnessing its natural resources, he added.

Growing urbanization meant increasing challenges to secure bulk water supply, electricity, housing and social infrastructure.

Currently the sanitation systems of all three coastal towns in Erongo are in need of refurbishment and enlargement, which is being addressed through the Revised Sanitation Strategy, Schlettwein said (*The Namibian 28-Jun-24, The Namibian 17-Apr-24*).

Swakop Uranium to the rescue

The Namibian government revealed in April that it would partner with Chinese-owned Swakop Uranium to construct the second desalination plant at the coast. Swakop Uranium's Husab Mine is majority owned by China General Nuclear Power Group.

The partnership was announced by Schlettwein during the launch of Nam-

Water's Kuiseb Collector 2 - Schwarzekuppe - Swakopmund pipeline project, for which the groundbreaking ceremony was held at Utuseb.

Tender W/ONB/NW-005/2024 for the replacement of Collector 1 - Schwarzekuppe - Swakopmund pipeline: Collector 2 - Collector 1 section was awarded to China's Unik Construction / CK Heydt Civils JV for N\$59.6-m, after nine of eleven tenderers including four Chinese were disqualified and another Chinese contractor was deemed the only other qualifying bidder (report in *Bulletin 1522*).

Construction on the second desalination project should commence next year, after feasibility studies and financing options had been concluded.

Plans for the second desalination plant have been in the pipeline since 2016, when government opted not to buy the Orano Desalination Plant because the asking price was too high. At the time Areva Resources had offered the plant to government for N\$3-b.

Swakop Uranium then proposed a joint venture with the Namibian government to build the second seawater desalination plant, which would also benefit its Husab Mine. The modular plant will have a capacity of at least 20-million m³ but could be expanded.

When considering the collaboration with the government, Husab Mine executive vice-president, Irvinne Simataa, said in 2022 the Mine lost 39 days of production because of the unavailability of water. Swakop Uranium during that time accounted for 65% to 70% of the water demand in the Erongo Region, which motivated the company to make the investment to fast-track water supply and "mitigate our business risk". The company had no intention of operating the plant he added.

The cost of the desalination plant has not been revealed but a project feasibility study indicated that it could cost over N\$3.5-b.

NamWater chief executive, Abraham Nehemia, announced in April that a new water storage reservoir would be built at Henties Bay after the successful

completion of the 10km pipeline replacement project (*New Era 16-Apr-24*).

Public Private Partnership with funding from development banks

Schlettwein confirmed in May that NamWater would collaborate with Swakop Uranium on this initiative and the project would soon be submitted to the Cabinet for approval. Feasibility studies for the new plant had been completed, and the project was in its final proposal stages.

"It will be developed through a public private partnership, with NamWater and the government seeking funding from local and international development banks," Schlettwein added.

Cabinet had already approved the project's first phase, which includes securing water supply systems for the central coast, Windhoek and other parts of the country. The new plant should significantly boost the Erongo Region's water supply capacity by converting seawater into potable water (*Windhoek Observer 15-May-24*).

Desalination consultancy tender cancelled over irregularity

Meanwhile, NamWater notified bidders on 12-Jun-24 that its consultancy tender related to a new desalination plant in the Erongo Region had been cancelled over an undisclosed irregularity.

The announcement on the water utility's website by NamWater's CEO, A Nehemia, said the tender process was cancelled with immediate effect in line with Section 54(1)(e) of the Public Procurement Act 15 of 2015, which provides for the cancellation when "an irregularity occurred that warrants the cancellation of the bidding process".

Tender SC/RP/NW-008/2024 called for the provision of geo-technical and geological services associated with the design of the proposed new desalination plant in the Erongo Region. The tender had closed on 16-Nov-23 but no bid opening register or further details could be found on the NamWater website.

The tender was posted only on NamWater's website on 02-Nov-24

as SC/RP/NW-007/2024 and listed in *Bulletin 1516*.

Henties Bay sub-division & rezoning

The Henties Bay municipality already announced in June last year the creation of a portion for the NamWater desalination plant and carriage system and called for objections to the subdivision of the remainder of Farm Henties Bay #133 (vacant and undeveloped) north east of the C34 to Terrace Bay, into Portion A and remainder.

This also involved the rezoning from 'undetermined' to 'parastatal', registration of a 15m 'waterline' servitude in favour of NamWater and a 15m 'right of way' servitude in favour of the general public and inclusion into the next zoning scheme for Henties Bay.

The purpose of the application was to enable the NamWater to build a desalination plant and carriage system in Henties Bay to help secure water supply to the central coast, Windhoek and en-route users. The process was conducted by Stubenrauch Planning Consultants and listed in the *Tender Bulletin* under 'Deadlines'.

But in November the proposed desalination plant was near Orano

During November last year NamWater held public information sharing meetings on the Draft Environmental & Social Impact Assessment report for the proposed desalination plant near the Orano Desalination Plant at Wlotzkasbaken and a water carriage system to secure water supply to the Central Coast as well as the proposed 35.1MWp Gainguu PV power plant with 33kV transmission line to the new Khan substation and associated infrastructure, (as reported in the *Tender Bulletin* at the time under 'Business Events'). This EIA process was conducted by SLR Environmental Consulting.

Two years earlier, in November 2019, SLR had started the EIA process on behalf of NamWater for the desalination plant and water carriage system to secure water supply to the central coastal area, Windhoek and en-route users (Arandis, Usakos, Karibib and Okahandja). NamWater proposed to develop a desalination plant and water carriage system, consisting of the desalination plant, a 350km long water pipeline from the coast to Windhoek and support infrastructure, including pump stations and power supply.

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UNAM'S N\$65-M SOLAR PROJECT READY THIS YEAR

12 JULY 2024

The University of Namibia's solar project is on track for completion this year, after it secured N\$65-m funding from the Development Bank of Namibia and Old Mutual earlier this year after commencing in the second quarter of 2023.

The solar project is a public private partnership called Inceptus Energy, which is a joint venture between Alensy Energy Solutions and Inceptus Holdings, the business arm of UNAM.

The project will add 3.68MW solar PV capacity to sustainable energy utilization in Namibia along with a 657kVA peak saving solution.

Financial services company IJG arranged debt and equity for the transaction.

During the financing ceremony, Alensy's CEO, Norbert Dörgeloh, said the project exemplified the synergy between the public and private sectors to drive renewable energy objectives forward.

Inceptus chief executive, Evaristus Evaristus, praised the project's role as testament to the university's dedication to sustainability and said he hoped it

would inspire similar initiatives.

UNAM vice-chancellor, Prof Kenneth Matengu, added the project plays a major role in reducing the university's dependency on non-renewable energy, reducing energy expenses and generating savings.

The project is expected to provide sustainable, reliable and cost effective electricity to the twelve UNAM campuses, while saving N\$12-m annually. The solar plants have an expected lifetime of over 25-years (*New Era, The Namibian 16-Feb-24; Mining & Energy website*).

Renewable Energy Generation Project launched in 2021

Inceptus Holdings (Pty) Ltd issued a Request for proposals in May 2021, inviting Namibian registered, appropriately qualified and experienced

UNAM vice-chancellor pointed out that the project features photovoltaic solar power generation plants with a total capacity of 3.4 Megawatt peak (MWP).

These plants utilise solar energy to produce electricity, which is then synchronized with the existing electrical grid, creating a grid-tied system.

Battery systems are also incorporated to reduce electricity demand peaks. The use of rooftop and car parking space for solar panels represents an innovative approach to maximizing limited space while maintaining aesthetically pleasing campus designs, Matengu said.

Dörgeloh, commended UNAM for its vision and initiative in partnering with the private sector to drive innovation. "The project showcases how the private sector and public sector can work together successfully.

Investment was raised by the private sector to benefit UNAM, without any public expenditure requirement," he said at the time. He also highlighted Namibia's favourable electricity regulation framework, which supports the investment and implementation of alternative energy solutions.
