


Business Delegation to Tashkent and Samarkand, Uzbekistan (8-14 April 2019) A Report

INTRODUCTION

India-Uzbekistan bilateral trade currently stands at around US\$ 350 million. In order to strengthen the strategic partnership, India and Uzbekistan have set an annual bilateral trade target of US\$1 billion to be achieved by 2020 and agreed to boost connectivity as the two sides recently signed 17 agreements across a range of sectors following delegation-level talks led by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Uzbekistan President Shavkat Mirziyoyev. India has extended Line of Credit (LoC) worth US\$200 million to Uzbekistan for housing and other social infrastructure projects and US\$800 million of Buyer's Credit from Exim Bank of India.

On the invitation of H.E. Mr Farhod Arziev, Ambassador, Embassy of the Republic of Uzbekistan in India, the Chamber mounted a business delegation to Tashkent and Samarkand, Uzbekistan from 8-14 April 2019 in its endeavour to strengthen the bilateral economic cooperation between India and CIS countries. The delegation comprised of representatives from the Healthcare, ICT and Food Processing sectors and the delegates had meaningful meetings with the following respective agencies in Uzbekistan.

The main objective of the delegation was to find business opportunities in Uzbekistan and interact with key decision-makers in the public as well as private sector to explore avenues and scope for the Indian businessmen.

DISCUSSION AND TAKEAWAYS

1. Meeting with Mr. Pramod Kumar Agarwal, Head of Chancery, Embassy of India in Tashkent



The delegation called on the Indian Embassy in Tashkent and met Mr. Pramod Kumar Agrawal, Head of Chancery and apprised him about their respective business interests. Mr Agrawal informed about the visit of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to Tashkent to attend Summit Meeting of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) during which India signed Memorandum of Obligations for obtaining status of the Member State of the SCO. The then Minister of State for External Affairs Shri M.J. Akbar visited Uzbekistan in November 2017 as special envoy of the Prime Minister to express condolences and pay respects at the grave of President Islam Karimov in Samarkand. In June 2017 India became a member of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation, of which Uzbekistan is a founding member. The Regional Anti-Terrorist Structure of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO-RATS) is headquartered in Tashkent. On 15 June 2017, the flag of India was raised at the SCO-RATS Headquarters in Tashkent. India has been actively participating in SCO and SCO-RATS events in Uzbekistan and other SCO countries.



Mr. Agrawal also apprised the delegation about the high level multi-sectoral delegation led by Mr. Abdulaziz Kamilov, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Uzbekistan visit to India in 2017 during which twenty-two contracts, worth more than US\$80 million, and 20 investment agreements, worth over US\$70 million, were signed.

Mr. Agrawal highlighted the various opportunities available specifically in the field of Agriculture & Food Processing, Healthcare & Pharmaceuticals and Information Technology. He updated the delegation about the Indian investments in the country and offered to provide assistance to Indian compnaies in linking with the relevant agencies in the region.

2. Meeting with BMB Trade Group



B2B meetings were organised for the PHDCCI Delegation with the members of BMB Trade Group led by Mr Bekzod Mamatkulov, Chairman of the Supervisory Board. BMB Trade Group employs a team of experts with diverse business backgrounds and knowledge in various fields of economy. Three subsidiaries (BMB Agro Trade, BMB Logistics and BMB Zomin Agro) and three joint ventures (Silverleafe BMB Agro Trade Group, BMB AZ Modern Engineering and Scientific and Production Center for the Development of Tea Production) have been established to realize the set of projects of the company.

BMB Trade Group and PHDCCI also signed an MOU on the occasion to promote and strengthen trade and economic relations of both the countries by focussing on SMEs and Skill Development.



3. Meeting with Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Uzbekistan



The PHDCCI delegation met the members of Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Uzbekistan. Mr. Oleg Rijichenko, Head of Investment Attraction Innovation and Development Department led the delegation on behalf the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Uzbekistan and agreed to revive the MOU that was signed between the two organisations on 28 October 2010.

4. Meeting with General Directorate of Health in Tashkent

The PHDCCI delegation met Mr. Ulugbek A Egamberdiev, Head of Department and Mr. Botirbek A Isabekov, Deputy Head, General Directorate of Health in Tashkent. They discussed and deliberated on of Super the need Speciality specialised Hospitals, training program for doctors, exchange programs for conducting CMEs and OPDs.





5. Meeting with UNICON



The PHDCCI delegation met Mr. Aziz Mukhitdinov, First Deputy Director, UNICON, an Information Technology Agency under the Ministry of Information Technology of Government of Uzbekistan. The agency responsible for standardisation regulations of **ICT** and Uzbekistan as well as Certification of Information **Instruments** (Software and Hardware). The Indian industry expressed their

interest in connecting the advance technology available in India with the pool of resources in Uzbekistan.

6. Meeting with Ministry for Development of Information Technologies and Communications of the Republic of Uzbekistan

The PHDCCI delegation met Mr Nodir Tursunov, Chief of IT, Ministry for Development of Information Technologies and Communications of the Republic of Uzbekistan. The agency is responsible for expansion of ICT technologies in Uzbekistan and has been mandated by the President to bring investment in ICT which will channelise the development of



Smart Cities, IT Centres in 14 locations of the country, Healthcare, High Speed Internet through Optical Fibres in Schools and Educational Institutes for free and other important sectors. The delegates informed about the various projects related to ICT in India and how they can be replicated in Uzbekistan at state and national level.



7. Dinner hosted by Embassy of India in Tashkent



The Embassy India in Tashkent hosted networking dinner for the Indian delegation before departure the to India. The delegation had a number of B₂B meetings with their counterparts during the 4 days visit to Uzbekistan. There

are a number of opportunities for the Indian industry into ICT, Healthcare & Pharmaceuticals, Agriculture & Food Processing and Smart Cities in Uzbekistan.

8. Meeting with National Cancer Center of Uzbekistan

PHDCCI continued its delegation with the presence of Mr. Aditya Talwar, Co-Founder and Dr. Amish Vora, Director, HOPE Oncology in Tashkent.
