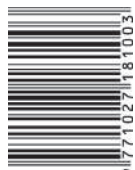
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Has Namport missed the boat?

NAMPORT'S 25-YEAR LEASE FOR THE OUTSOURCED MANAGEMENT OF ITS N\$4.2-B NEW CONTAINER TERMINAL IN WALVIS BAY HARBOUR STARTS A YEAR LATE THIS MONTH WITH A SWITZERLAND-BASED CONCESSIONAIRE AT THE HELM, TASKED WITH BOOSTING CONTAINERISED SHIPPING VOLUMES TO GENERATE SUFFICIENT PROFITS WITH WHICH TO REPAY NAMIBIA'S N\$2.4-B DEBT TO THE AFRICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK FOR THE GROSSLY UNDER-UTILIZED FACILITY THAT IS FACING STIFF COMPETITION FROM ANGOLA'S LOBITO HARBOUR, WHILE REMAINING HAMSTRUNG BY THE LACK OF REGIONAL RAIL LINKAGES TO THE INTERIOR DESPERATELY NEEDED TO INCREASE CARGO VOLUMES - PAGE 2

Almost two years after Namport awarded a 25-year concession for outsourcing the management of its N\$4.2-b new container terminal in Walvis Bay harbour, it has eventually been announced that the privatised project will start this month by Terminal Investment Namibia, tasked with boosting containerised shipping volumes to generate sufficient profits with which to repay the N\$2.4-b debt to the African Development Bank for the under-utilized facility. But the terminal is facing stiff competition from Angola's Lobito Harbour and remains hamstrung by the lack of rail linkages to the interior needed to increase cargo volumes.

The eventual activation of the concession by Terminal Investment Namibia (TIN) - a subsidiary formed by Terminal Investments Ltd for the undertaking - was announced by the ports authority last month after protracted negotiations over the terms of the agreement lasting 22 months. Terminal Investments Limited is based in Switzerland and is a corporate associate of Mediterranean Shipping Company (MSC).

At the official handover on 11 September, Namport's CEO, Andrew Kanime said: "The concession allows us to attract private capital to invest in crucial upgrades, including dredging the entrance channel and acquiring new equipment".

The partnership with TIN "will ensure Namport stays competitive and contribute to Namibia's vision of becoming a logistics hub".

The terminal was built by a Chinese contractor under controversial procurement circumstances and commissioned in 2019 with a capacity handling 750,000 containers annually.

"TIN is committed to bringing innovative practices and advanced operational standards to Namibia," said its chief executive Alexander Reali said in an accompanying statement (*The Namibian*, 12-Sep-24).

Terminal not up to expectations

Namport went on to say: "This strategic decision was premised on the need to attract private capital to invest in, amongst others, the widening and deepening of the channel at the port (to attract larger vessels), the acquisition of new equipment and new systems, the need to drive competitiveness through improved efficiencies, harnessing more cargo volumes to maximise utilisation of the terminal, and to preserve and grow levels of employment."

In respect of increasing volumes through the port, managing director at Novaship, Willie Prosser, told *Freight News* during a visit to Namibia in March 2023 that the port was simply not seeing the volumes they had hoped for.

He said the port's logistics industry had been waiting since 2019 for the promised hinterland cargo that the container terminal had anticipated.

Sarah Walker, sales director at Stacks Logistics at the time, said Walvis Bay was losing business on account of stiff rates.

Capable of handling 750,000 TEUs, Namport said the agreement with TIN "is expected to play a crucial role in bolstering Namibia's position as a key logistics hub in Southern Africa, through increased shipping connectivity, heightened vessel traffic, enlarged container handling capacity and enhanced operation efficiencies".

The edge TIN is expected to give MSC in the wider market is further bolstered by last year's emergence of Africa Global Logistics after MSC acquired Bolloré Africa Logistics.

The concession agreement, Kanime said, "will without doubt entrench Namibia and Namport's competitiveness amongst other coastal states and developing ports in the region

and significantly contribute towards the attainment of Namibia's vision to be the logistics hub for the region".

The privatisation development follows as Angola's much-vaunted corridor connecting the Port of Lobito with the Copperbelt on the border of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), continues to grow in industrial appeal, offering the shortest possible distance for pit-to-port evacuation and back-haul logistics into Africa's basin for copper and cobalt extraction.

To mitigate the perceived threat from the Lobito Corridor, the Walvis Bay Corridor Group recently said that there was a new North-West Corridor (NWC) developing that would drastically shorten the hinterland route through Namibia's Zambezia (formerly Caprivi) panhandle into Zambia and north to the Copperbelt.

However, the necessary road construction south of the mines at Kolwezi (DRC) and Solwezi (Zambia), through Kasempa and Kaoma to an existing but fast-dilapidating bitumen-grade route through Mongu to Sesheke, is lagging well behind schedule, according to *Freight News*.

Namport's joint statement with TIN's announcement said as a matter of urgency, the concession agreement "includes immediate dredging activities aimed at widening and deepening the entrance channel to 16 metres".

Through deepening the port's entry draught, larger vessels bringing in more cargo is expected to realise Walvis Bay's volume ambitions (<https://www.freightnews.co.za>, 12-Sep-24).

Falling container volumes and Lobito challenge

According to Namport's latest annual report - for 2022/23 - the volume of twenty-foot equivalent [container] units (TEUs) handled decreased by 4% to 160,883 TEUs (2022: 168,278 TEUs). The decrease was primarily due to the reduced transshipment volumes.

However, container import and export volumes recorded a year-on-year increase of 0.4% and 9%, respectively. This indicates increasing demand from the local and regional markets.

Ironically, the number of container vessels visiting Walvis Bay harbour declined dramatically to 160 in 2022/23 from 356 in 2016/17 - before the construction of the new container terminal commenced in 2019/20, by which time such visits had fallen to 278 (see accompanying table).

The report notes with some concern that "[t]he Port of Lobito in Angola is a significant regional competitor due to its strategic location and infrastructure investments. As an alternative gateway for landlocked countries such as the DRC and Zambia, the port has grown in recent years and has attracted cargo traditionally routed through the Port of Walvis Bay."

Further augmenting the port's growing stature is the 30-year concession that was signed at the end of 2022 for rail services and logistical support for the 1,290km Lobito Corridor, linking Lobito to Luau in Angola's east, "close to the DRC border and offers the shortest route for copper and cobalt from DRC and Zambia".

It also offers increased capacity for the transit of liquids and gases. The corridor is being lined up for some \$250-m in financing from the United States' Development Finance Corporation. The United States has also mooted an expansion of the Lobito corridor to the Tanzanian coast.

The report goes on to say that Lobito's strategic location and infrastructure improvements "could potentially divert trade flows away from Walvis Bay."

"Furthermore, changes in trade agreements or tariffs between Angola, Zambia and DRC could impact cargo routing decisions, favouring Lobito over

"Lobito's increasing prominence may shape market perceptions, making it a more attractive option for cargo owners and shipping lines."

And worse, "[i]f the United States investment extends to the Tanzanian coast, it would further dent Walvis Bay's competitiveness for hinterland cargo."

To mitigate these competitive challenges, Namport says it is committed to strategic investments in port infrastructure and equipment.

"We recognise the significance of enhancing the capacity of the entrance channel to handle larger vessels, and dredging is one of the key considerations for the New Container Terminal concessioning project."

Desperately seeking rail links

The report goes on to state that rail network connectivity is critical to the competitiveness of Namibian ports.

"Unfortunately, the lack of a rail connection to either Botswana or Zambia significantly impacts our ports' effectiveness in serving landlocked countries."

"A reliable and efficient rail link to the hinterland is crucial for port efficiency and cost-effectiveness" while "[t]he absence of rail connections further limits the ports' capacities to handle growing shares of hinterland cargo" and results in higher transportation costs for cargo owners, making the overall logistics chain less competitive.

"It is imperative to address the lack of rail connectivity to enhance the competitiveness of Namibian ports. Plans for the development of the Trans-Zambezi and Trans-Kalahari railway networks exist at the Namibian Government level, but investment decisions for both projects are still pending."

The Trans-Zambezi rail feasibility is concluded and confirms possible viability for a rail link [to Walvis Bay], while the Trans-Kalahari rail feasibility assessment is not yet finalized, the report notes.

"The lack of a rail connection to Botswana or Zambia poses a significant challenge to the competitiveness of Namibian ports. By securing rail connectivity, we strive to strengthen the competitive position of Namibian ports in Southern Africa and enhance the overall logistics network's effectiveness", it adds.

"By advocating for rail infrastructure development, we aim to improve overall port efficiency, reduce transportation costs and attract a greater share of hinterland cargo."

The long wait

Bulletin 1531 reported in March that one year after the contract to the Switzerland-based concessionaire was supposed to have kicked off, there was still no progress on implementation of the project that critics describe as a white elephant that should never have been built in the first place.

At the InterModal Africa maritime conference in Swakopmund on 28 February, Namport's CEO, Andrew Kanime did not provide reasons for the delay in signing the agreement and handing over the terminal's operations to TIN.

He only said the pending agreement would unlock financing to deepen the harbour entrance, allowing vessels carrying up to 14,000 TEUs (20-foot containers) to dock at the terminal, from the current 9,000 TEUs - without indicating where the finances would come from.

Kanime also enthused about expanded trade volumes resulting from the intensifying offshore oil exploration activities along Namibia's coastline and said Namport was planning to expand Lüderitz Harbour in relation to the rollout of the green hydrogen programme.

Speaking at the same conference, Namibia's deputy minister of Works & Transport, John Mutorwa, said the Walvis Bay - Lubumbashi and Trans-Kalahari transport corridors would contribute to cross-border trade and enhance Namibia's role as regional logistics hub (*Die Republikein*, 01-Mar-24).

But at the time, Namport and TIN were still locked in negotiations over finalising the terms of their agreement, conditions and implementation schedules.

All that came from Namport's side publicly was a reaffirmation that TIN's majority shareholder and main client, MSC Mediterranean Shipping Company, for which securing increasingly restricted terminal capacity was critical to MSC's core container shipping business.

Namport had already announced in 2022 that Swiss-based container terminal operator Terminal Investment Limited (TIL) was the preferred bidder to run the new container terminal at the Port of Walvis Bay.

The N\$4.2-b new container terminal consists of a new quay with two berths, a container yard, turning basin, four Panamax ship to shore cranes and ancillary equipment.

The terminal was built to expand the port's capacity of 350,000 TEUs annually, which was approaching full utilization.

Terms of the concession

The Namibian Investment Promotion & Development Board (NIPDB) issued an expression of interest under the Walvis Bay Industrial Development Initiative (WIDI) in August 2021, which included the management and operation of the new container terminal plus two other projects to be run by private operators.

Namport then floated its own expression of interest on 08-Apr-22 and short-listed several bidders, who were invited to submit proposals by early June that year to lease the N\$4.2-b container terminal for 25 years after the port utility had taken over the WIDI from the NIPDB (*Bulletin 1445*).

Namport's EOI for the terminal concession contained a draft agreement with the preferred bidder, of which the salient terms included:

- * payment of an upfront take-on fee on signing of concessioning agreement;
- * stipulation of and commitment to volumes for transshipments, gateway and corridor containers to be moved through the terminal; provision is made for penalties chargeable in the case where the volume commitments are not met;
- * the concessionaire will undertake that the terminal will be available for use on a com-

mon user and equitable basis, i.e. will be a multi-user facility;

- * there will be no exclusive handling of containers in the port by the concessionaire/operator at this stage;
- * the concessionaire will only be permitted to handle containers and limited project cargo and not non-containerized cargo;
- * key performance indicators will be used to drive operational performance and enhance efficiencies: SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic and Time-bound) performance standards will be set for the operator;
- * the concession term will be 25 years in line with international benchmarks and consistent with the need to allow for recoupment of investments to be made by the operator;
- * the concession includes the option to expand the terminal (quay and yard) to increase throughput capacity from the current 750,000 TEUs; and
- * the operator will be required to maintain or better the current terms and conditions of employment, including an undertaking to guarantee employment of the personnel taken over for a minimum period (*Bulletin 1445*).

How the current agreement between Namport and TIL compares to this, is unclear, but probably provides for a lot more - including dredging a deeper channel by TIL for larger container ships.

Terminal Investments Limited

Namport announced on 14 October 2022 that Terminal Investment Limited (TIL) was the winning bidder expected to breathe life into the ailing new container terminal (NCT) built on an artificial island in Walvis Bay harbour.

Switzerland-based Terminal Investment Limited was selected from five other companies short-listed by Namport as possible concessionaires.

Ranked seventh amongst the world's port terminal operators by Marine Insight, TIL beat third-ranked Dubai Ports World (DPW) who had earlier been promoted as the leading contender to run Namport's NCT.

TIL is partly owned by the Mediterranean Shipping Company, which is the largest shipping line in the world by container capacity.

Only two of the five global operators that were invited to bid responded with offers, according to Namport. The second bid received was from Abu Dhabi Ports.

Negotiations commenced between Namport and TIL in 2022 on the concession agreement, focusing on operational matters such as the exact terms and conditions on personnel to be taken over by the operator, Kanime said at the time.

TIL has interests in over 60 terminals and handles at least one million Twenty-Foot Equivalent Unit (TEU)s annually, operating in 31 countries across five continents.

It was expected to grow cargo volumes through the Walvis Bay terminal beyond its current capacity of 750,000 TEUs annually.

"We are happy with the business case proposed by TIL and are confident that this is aligned to the fundamental objectives we have set for the concession of the NCT", Kanime said at the time, adding that the finalization of the negotiations and the handover process was expected to be concluded by the first quarter of 2023 "if both parties involved agree on all proposed terms and conditions" - which obviously too a lot more horse trading to materialise.

Falling container volumes

Kanime admitted at the time that Namport's utilisation of the container terminal stood at 23% in October 2022, which was not ideal for business and employment levels.

"Any decrease in current volumes can spell serious negative outcomes for the overall business and we need to mitigate the risk by targeting the growth of business volumes sufficient to provide healthy margins and guarantee employment," he said.

The concession is supposed to allow Namport to recoup its investment and the contract will also entail the expansion of the terminal quay and yard to increase throughput and accommodate larger vessels.

TIL already operates two ports in West Africa and South Africa was engaging in a similar process as Namibia to get the Swiss firm to handle its Durban Harbour, as well as others (*Namport Quayside Bulletin*, Oct-22).

Kanime defended the selection of a foreign concessionaire because Namibia did not have the capacity to grow the planned volumes and operate the terminal. Which begs the question why the Namibian government decided to go ahead with such a massive project that it could not afford in the first place.

The decision to handle transshipments is made "by either the shipping line or an operator who has a relationship or cooperation with a shipping line," according to Kanime. For this reason it would not be practical to expect local business people to operate the NCT.

Namibia would benefit from the exponential growth in business handled through the Port of Walvis Bay stemming from this foreign direct investment.

"The ownership of the terminal and all other port operations, such as marine services, will continue to vest in Namport," he added. The Port utility would also remain in full control of all security aspects.

Namibia's small market could never sustainably support the full operations of the terminal. "The business opportunity we identified was that we could construct the terminal and then engage an operator who can bring in significant business that would take our volumes throughput to very high levels and earn us as a country and the owner of the terminal some very good returns," he said (*The Namibian*, *New Era* 17-Oct-22; *The Namibian*, *Namib Times* 21-Oct-22; *The Namibian* 03-Nov-22).

However, one year later, in its performance review for the third quarter of 2022/23, Namport admitted that TEUs handled had decreased by 7% compared to the previous year, "mainly due to the decreased transshipment containers handled".

This slump took place alongside a 32% increase to 1.7 million tons in cross-border cargo and an 18% increase in total cargo to 820,243 tons, however, while bulk and break bulk cargo rose from 3.0 million tons in 2021 to 3.8 million tons in 2022 (*Namport Quayside Bulletin* Jan-23).

This decrease in TEU volumes is precisely what the concession to TIL is meant to reverse - now that it has commenced.

The tender for the construction of the new container terminal (NCT) built on land reclaimed from the sea was controversially awarded by Namport to China Harbour Engineering Company in November 2013 at an initial contract value of N\$3.38-b, escalating to N\$4.2-b upon completion in 2019.

CHEC was blacklisted by the World Bank at the time for procurement irregularities in various locations.

Shipping downturn

In April 2022, Kanime explained that the decision to lease out the terminal became a reality when the dynamics of the shipping industry significantly shifted due to depressed macro-economic conditions, which negatively impacted industries across all sectors.

This resulted in decreasing imports and exports handled through Namibian and other regional ports, while shipping lines moved to the deployment of larger vessels to rationalise costs.

"These unforeseen and unfortunate developments caused a significant decrease in the volume throughput through the new container terminal. Given the need to earn a return on this very strategic investment, we have been compelled to explore means and ways [by which] we can drive the utilisation of the terminal," he said.

The decrease in Namport revenue was largely due to the decline in volumes throughout and dockings at the ship repair facilities as a result of the Covid-19 impact on international trade.

Kanime also admitted that well before the effects of Covid-19 were felt in 2019, the terminal never handled the freight volumes it was built for.

Several Namibian economists had warned even before the completion of the NCT, that this project would become another white elephant because container shipping was declining worldwide.

The feasibility study for the Walvis Bay port expansion was done by Namport in 2011, when TEU through Walvis Bay peaked at 334,000 containers, after which it decreased to 203,000 in 2017.

When the African Development Bank agreed to the N\$3-b loan in mid-2013, shipping was already in decline.

Namport's finance executive, Kevin Harry, confirmed in May 2022 that Namibia still owed the AfDB N\$2.4-b on its loan for the construction of the container terminal, the balance of which was financed by Namport and government contributions. (Detailed information was published in *Bulletin 1445*.)

Another white elephant

In an opinion piece in *The Namibian* newspaper one year before the container terminal was commissioned in 2019, UNAM economics professor Roman Grynberg predicted that the port expansion project would turn out to be another white elephant.

The Chinese-built facility will in effect increase the size of the port to carry 1.05 million TEU (twenty foot equivalent containers) annually from the current 350,000 TEU, and "will probably result in a further deepening of Namibia's economic morass because Namport, which should be able to carry the debt for the expansion from revenues, may not be able to do so and the government of course has had to provide loan guarantees to the lenders" [AfDB].

"The problem is that container shipping at Walvis Bay is not growing but is in rapid decline. Most importantly, the trans-Kalahari railway from Botswana has not and probably will not progress and container traffic in transit through the port is in decline", Grynberg warned.

The trans-shipment to Angola was supposed to be the economic basis for the expansion of the Walvis Bay port "but to assume that Angola would not develop its own ports ... and that Walvis Bay would continue to act as its major trans-shipment centre was economic folly".

He pointed out that new ports are being constructed all over Angola by the Chinese at Cabinda with a N\$7.2-b loan from China, together with an expansion of the container port at Lobito at the end of the Chinese reconstructed N\$20-b Benguela Railway to DRC and Zambia,

with the first shipments of manganese from DRC arriving at Lobito in Angola earlier in 2018.

"The question that Namibians must ask is how did the nation get into this mess and how do we stop the development of yet more multibillion dollar white elephants?"

The market section of the feasibility study for the Walvis Bay port expansion was done by Namport in 2011 when TEU through Walvis Bay peaked at 334,000 containers, after which it decreased to 203,000 in 2017 "but according to the AfDB projections it was supposed to be 561,000 TEU by 2017 [which turned out not to be the case].

Crucially, Grynberg observed, most of the decline was because of the collapse of trans-shipment [which Namport's envisaged public private partnership now relies on to boost revenues].

The economic expert accurately predicted: "This will mean that, based on current throughput, the new 1.1 million TEU port will operate at 20% capacity and that the expansion was simply an unnecessary investment that Namport will now struggle to repay".

The growth of shipping in 2011 made it look possible to believe that a 1.1 million TEU port might make sense one day in the very distant future but only so long as the trans-shipment traffic to Angola continued.

"No-one, especially the AfDB, should have assumed such a thing, which should have done its own assessment when it finally agreed to the N\$3-b loan in mid-2013 by which time shipping was already in decline.

"This white elephant is not just a case of unfortunate future projections on shipping demand as this could have been foreseen by 2013 if there was a proper review by AfDB just prior to disbursement", according to Grynberg.

He continued: "The only way to stop this sort of economic folly from continuing and ultimately bankrupting Namibia, which no-one should doubt will be the end result, is for the President and National Assembly to protect the people from some of their ministers.

"Some, but not all ministers build white elephants out of pure vanity and hubris and the hope that it will be a 'pyramid' in their name. Others have even less noble objectives such as getting kick-backs which are common in such large infrastructure projects."

He added that the planning ministry should be mandated to conduct an independent review of all infrastructure projects using proper economic cost-benefit analysis, but "the ministry cannot be trusted not to be leaned on by one or other powerful ministers to give a favourable outcome".

Grynberg pointed out that earlier in 2018 the IMF had "warned Namibia that one of the nation's greatest financial risks lies among our state owned enterprises and their penchant for such sub-economic projects" and that "proper facts-based cost-benefit analysis be done by an independent parliamentary body before any large infrastructure project is approved" (*Bulletin 1445* - Roman Grynberg writing in *The Namibian*, 24 August 2018).

DESCRIPTION: Invitation to apply for a share in the Norwegian beef export quota 2025.

Eligible organisations are invited to apply for a share in the Norwegian beef quota available to Namibia for the production and export of beef to Norway. The quota will be awarded to eligible organisations (i.e. approved for beef production and exports to Norway) and is valid for the period from 01-Jan-25 to 31-Dec-25. New entrants that meet the requirements are encouraged to apply. The sharing and allocation of the 1,600 Ton quota will be done in accordance with the principles outlined in the Government Approved Norway Quota Award Allocation Model (14-May-24) as well as the LLPBN Norway Implementation Rules (29-Aug-24). All applicants must attach the following documents/information: (1) covering letter motivating the award of the quota and stipulating the total tonnage of beef applied for the calendar year 2025; (2) statutory documents proving incorporation of legal entity; (3) historic slaughter numbers and beef export volumes, indicating demonstrated capacity to export the beef tonnage applied for; (4) proof of compliance with corporate statutory requirements, incl. clearance of LLPBN levies as at date of application; (5) existing beneficiaries of the quota must ensure that a full disclosure of consignments (with LLPBN permit numbers) undertaken and cleared in 2024 is attached to the application. **SUBMIT:** Written applications clearly marked 'Norwegian Quota' should be in a confidential envelope addressed to the LLPBN CEO

STADIUM UPGRADE SHAMBLES DRAGS ON

4 OCTOBER 2024

The Ministry of Sport, Youth & National Service has been accused of excluding local bidders from tendering for the lead consultant in the Independence Stadium upgrade, estimated to be worth N\$60-m.

The requirements to bid for the consultancy tender were reportedly raised from projects worth N\$200-m to N\$500-m, after last year's consultancy tender was reportedly scrapped and re-issued in July this year.

Marley Tjitjo Architects, responsible for the construction of the controversial N\$1-b Home Affairs Head Office in Windhoek, is reportedly one of two short-listed companies under the latest tender, alongside Kerry McNamara Architects in partnership with Toivo Nuugulu Architects.

The *Tender Bulletin* has no record of this consultancy tender being re-advertised on the MSYNS website or the GRN eProcurement portal.

But *The Namibian* reported on 23-Jul-24 that the bidding process was cancelled on recommendation of the Review Panel in the finance ministry and re-started on 03-Jul-24 with a closing date of 29-Jul-24.

MSYNS executive director Erastus Haitangela confirmed that in June two potential bidders had challenged the bidding process, flagging errors in the procurement procedure.

He expressed the hope that a consultant would be appointed by the end of August and that the lead consultant would appoint multiple contractors to speed up the upgrading process.

NNN not impressed with the lack of progress

SWAPO's presidential candidate, Netumbo Nandi-Ndaitwah, recently criticized sports minister Agnes Tjongarero for the lack of progress on the renovation of the stadium, which has forced the Namibian national football team to play abroad for their international games in recent years.

The Namibia Football Association

A fourth round of tendering is underway to find consultants for the upgrade of the Independence Stadium, amidst ongoing secrecy and delays on the project that has doubled in cost to N\$1-b and for which the contractor was supposed to be on site in April

had to spend millions on hosting the national team's home games out of the country since 2020, because the Independence Stadium is deemed unfit to host international matches.

The sports minister had promised that renovations would commence after the successful contractor was supposed to have been announced by the end of August - but there is no progress to report, Nandi-Ndaitwah lamented. The country's current vice-president felt that she was being misled and threatened to hold ministerial officials accountable.

Opposition activist Job Amupanda on 29-Aug-24 claimed that Nandi-Ndaitwah had misled the public, after a video emerged where she promised in July that the successful bidder would be announced on 28-Aug-24.

The cost for renovating the stadium is estimated to close to N\$1-billion - up from previous estimates between N\$500-m and N\$800-m.

According to the MSYNS's Haitengela, the ministry currently had a budget of N\$80-m. This amount is designated for 'Works' on the stadium under Open Advertised Bidding on the MSYNS annual procurement plan for the 2024/25 FY, while no amount is listed under consulting services (*The Namibian* 23-Jul-24; *Namibian Sun* 02-Sep-24; *Confident*, *The Namibian* 06-Sep-24).

The previous three consulting tenders

Tender Bulletin 1518 reported on 17-Nov-23 that ten consultants bid for the third attempt at planning the Independence Stadium upgrade, after two such tenders flopped in 2022.

Ten offers were received for the provision of lead consultancy services (architectural, civil/structural, electrical and mechanical engineering and quantity surveying) for the design, docu-



mentation and supervision for the upgrading and renovation of the Independence Stadium in Windhoek to Confederation of African Football (CAF) Stadium Regulations Category 3, when tender SC/RP/027-05/2023 closed at the Ministry of Sport, Youth & National Service on 24-Oct-23.

The technical proposal opening posted on the MSYNS website listed proposals from:

- * AK Consulting Engineers / MVD JV
- * DB - Ndlovu Icon Architects
- * Gamal Rfai Architects (SSC expired)
- * Kamau Architects
- * Marley Tjitjo Architects

- * Toivo Nuugulu Architects / Bob Mould Architects.

This tender followed the cancellation of two expressions of interest for consultancy services for the upgrade on 09-Sep-22, because "bids could not be evaluated within the regulated timeframe," according to the ministry's executive director Haitengela at the time. Both tenders had closed on 06-Jun-22 and were published in May-22 as 'Expressions of Interest' for consulting services - the bid references were only added in the cancellation notice:

- * Electrical & mechanical: SC/RP/02-01/2022 [this reference is clearly incorrect: EOI for electrical and mechanical engineering consultancy services for the upgrading and renovation of the Independence Stadium in Windhoek;

* Civil & structural: SC/RP/027-01/2022: EOI for civil and structural engineering consultancy services for the upgrading and renovation of the Independence Stadium in Windhoek.

The first round of tenders advertised under different reference numbers had closed on 07-Apr-22. These were issued with 'consultancy services' tender references and called on experienced and competent engineering consultants to provide professional consulting services for the design, procurement and construction supervision of the renovation of the Independence Stadium.

Contractor supposed to be on site by April

Deputy sports minister, Emma Kantema-Gaomas, promised in Nov-23, that the successful bidder for the refurbishment of the Independence Stadium would be announced before April 2024.

Commenting on the ambitious cut-off date, she explained that the procurement process had been planned to ensure that the contract would be awarded swiftly.

The ministry decided to upgrade the Independence Stadium to Category 3 - upgradable to Category 4 CAF standards to enable senior men's and women's national teams to play their CAF and FIFA home matches in Namibia.

CAF stadium regulations prescribe detailed technical requirements that have to be met for each category of stadium, including pitch and surrounding areas, facilities for teams and CAF officials, medical areas, spectator and media sections, VIP and hospitality areas and training facilities.

Lack of maintenance and over-utilization of Namibia's biggest stadium over many years has led to it being declared unfit for hosting international football matches.

The Sam Nujoma Stadium in Katutura is also unfit to host major sporting events (*The Namibian Sun* 06-Nov-23; *Die Republieken* 07-Nov-23, *Tender Bulletin* 1518).

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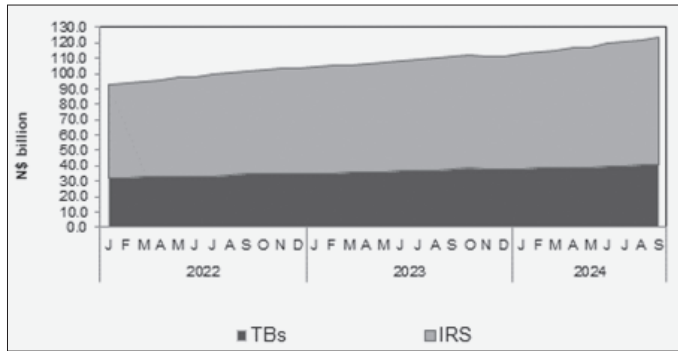
GRN DOMESTIC DEBT GROWS 11% TO N\$123.5-B

4 OCTOBER 2024

Namibia's domestic government debt reached N\$123.5-b during September, reflecting a 1.7% increase during the month and 11% year-on-year,

according to the Bank of Namibia's latest monthly report.

Sales of treasury bills rose to N\$41.2-b and internal registered stock to N\$82.3-b – both by 1.7% during the



month, while year-on-year, the issuance of TBs rose 9.5% and IRSs by 11.8%.

As a percentage of GDP, domestic debt increased to 48% - by 0.8 percentage point month-on-month and

0.4% on an annual basis, reflecting increased ratios of IRSs to GDP of 0.5 percentage point.

The ratio of TBs to GDP declined by 0.1 percentage point.

UNAM has cancelled its tender for revamping the dining hall at its main campus in Windhoek, according to a notice posted on its website.

Tender W/ONB/UNAM-03/2024 closed 23-May-24 with fourteen offers for demolishing some walls and floors; erecting new walls, ceilings and counters; joinery, tiling, aluminium works, electrical, water and sewer works and casting a new concrete floor.

This Open National Bidding tender was posted only on UNAM's website on 15-Apr-24, but the attachment became visible only on 18-Apr-24.

According to the executive summary posted on the UNAM website, the tender had to be cancelled because all bids received were non-responsive.

While its cost estimate for the works was N\$3.5-m, the bids received ranged

Tender re-issued after all fourteen offers from N\$2.5-m to N\$5.8-m were non-responsive

from N\$2.5-m to N\$5.8-m.

Thirteen tenderers were deemed non-compliant because they did not have at least three completion certificates for similar alteration projects worth over N\$5-m. Most bidders submitted proof of only one or two projects over N\$5-m, or the projects were not for similar services.

This applies to all bidders except Roha Investment, whose price may have been recorded incorrectly.

Other problems identified during the bid evaluation were also recorded where applicable. The offers were, in ascending price order:
