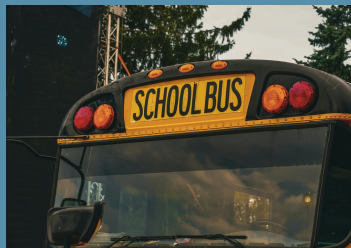

MORE DETAILS:

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Safety In schools is essential for children's growth and learning. It encompasses physical safety, including secure buildings, fire drills, and safe playg rounds; health safety, such as access to clean water, tollets, and to first aid; and emotional safety. A safe school environment allows students to focus on learning, parents to trust the system, and teachers to teach without stress, ensuring overall development in a protected and supportive atmosphere.
