Your Managing Committee is pleased to present their 120th Managing Committee Report on the operations and affairs of PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry ("Chamber") for the financial Year 2024-25.

Performance of the Chamber

The total income of the Chamber has decreased by 15.67% from Rs. 75.05 crore for the year 2023-24 to Rs. 63.29 crore for the year 2024-25.

Similarly, surplus of the Chamber has decreased by 86.97% from Rs. 3.61 crore for the year 2023-24 to Rs. 0.47 crore for the year 2024-25.

The Change in the Nature of Business

During the Year, there is no change in the nature of business of the Chamber.

Members of Managing Committee

The Managing Committee of the Chamber for the year 2023-24 continued to guide the activities of the Chamber till the Managing Committee for 2024-25, which was constituted at the 119th Annual General Meeting held on 10th October, 2024 at Vigyan Bhawan, New

Delhi. The newly elected Managing Committee unanimously elected Mr. Hemant Jain as President; Mr. Rajeev Juneja as Senior Vice President and Mr. Anil Gupta as Vice President. The Immediate Former President, Mr. Sanjeev Agrawal became 'ipso facto' Member and Twenty Eight (28) were Elected Members for the year 2024-25 to 2025-26 and Six (6) Members were Co-opted to the Managing Committee for the year 2024 -25.

Ministers / Senior Government officials of the various Departments concerning trade, industry and services sectors, eminent economists and experts were invited to address / interact with the members of the Managing Committee of the Chamber on issues of national importance.

The President, accompanied by Senior Vice President / Vice President / Chairs / Co-Chairs of the concerned Expert Committees / State Chapters / Task Forces, also called on several Union Ministers, Chief Ministers and Senior Central and State Government officials and submitted views of the Chamber on issues of concern to trade, industry and services sectors.

Reserves

During the Year, the Chamber has transferred Rs. 47.06 lakh to the General Reserve.

Deposits

The Chamber has not invited any deposits from Public/Members during the financial year ended on 31st March 2025.

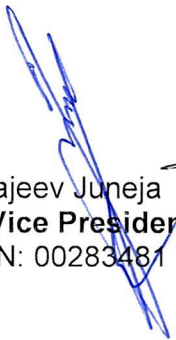

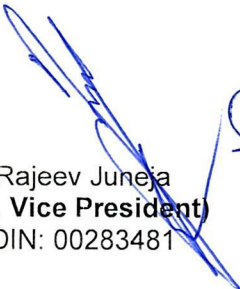
