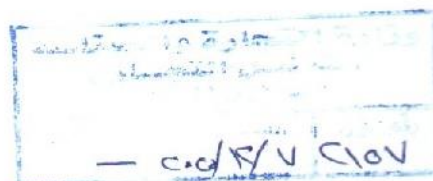

LE11,000 per driver; LE10,000 cashback from

The new vehicle arrives fully insured,  
runs on inexpensive dual gasoline/CNG,  
and costs the same or less to operate than a  
traditional tuk-tuk.

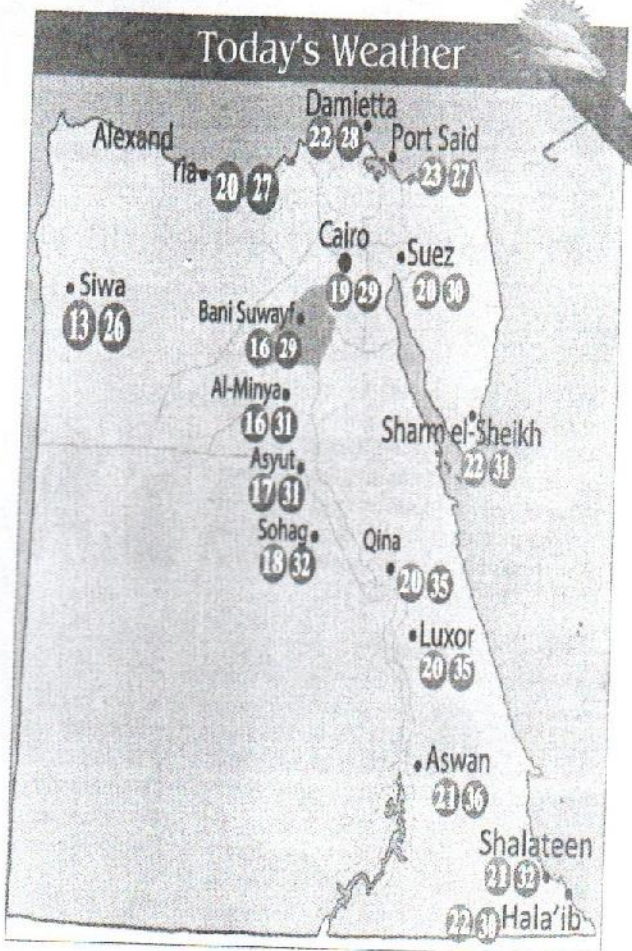
Early Qute vehicles are already plying  
pilot routes. Fares will be fixed, slightly  
higher than today's rates yet still affordable,  
reflecting the leap in safety and comfort.

The vehicles' fuel efficiency and en-  
closed cabins with seatbelts are expected to  
win rapid public favour, creating the very  
demand Marie predicts will pull hesitant  
drivers across.

"A final coordination meeting will lock  
in the exact tariff and fine-tune the replace-  
ment mechanism. Additional incentives are  
on the way.

"We are betting on citizens themselves  
preferring the new, safer vehicle," Marie  
said. "Public demand will be the real driver  
of change."

The plan aims to create safer, quieter, and  
better-organised transport, primarily to re-  
duce accidents and traffic jams.
