

Security Council reform, encouraging European partners to support reforms in international financial institutions, facilitate technology transfer, and expand access to concessional financing.

Madbouli highlighted Egypt's tangible and active contribution to regional security efforts. These include securing the Sharm el-Sheikh agreement to consolidate the Gaza ceasefire and supporting political solutions in Sudan and Libya, combatting terrorism in the Sahel and contributing funding to the African Union Support and Stabilisation Mission in Somalia, as well as maintaining security for Red Sea navigation and supporting stability restoration in eastern DR Congo.

Concluding his remarks, Prime Minister Madbouli condemned human rights violations in El Fasher, Sudan, and decisively rejected any unilateral measures in the Horn of Africa or the Red Sea that threaten the sovereignty of states. He expressed Egypt's readiness to strengthen collaboration with European partners through its specialised institutions, including the Cairo International Centre for Conflict Resolution, Peacekeeping and Peacebuilding, the Egyptian Agency of Partnership for Development, and the Cairobased African Space Agency.

Egypt's participation at the summit reinforces its standing as a continental leader committed to driving sustainable peace, robust development, and a strong, unified voice for Africa on the world stage.

What do you think of when you hear the word "design?" Most people will probably think of something rather general and non-specific, like when thinking of the word "art," "power," "love," or "dream." Why Israel's p

N Security Council Resolution 2803 is destined to fail. That failure will come at a price: more Palestinian deaths, extensive destruction and the expansion of Israeli violence to the West Bank and elsewhere in the Middle East.

The resolution, passed last week, was a consolation prize for Israel after it failed to achieve its ultimate objective from the two-year Gaza genocide: the ethnic cleansing of the population and its complete takeover of the Strip.

Gaza shattered a core Israeli doctrine: the absolute certainty of its military supremacy's ability to subdue the Palestinian people using far superior US and Western-supplied technology. Though the occupation was never expected to be easy - as Israel's history of violence in the Strip attests the complete takeover was, in the minds of the Israeli leadership, a foregone conclusion. In August, Israeli Benjamin Minister Netanyahu stated with total confidence that Israel aimed to "take control of all of Gaza." That proved to be wishful thinking.
