- Guided visit(s) to U.S. Bankruptcy Courts with live courtroom observation (subject to court schedules).
- Curated interactions with leading U.S. bankruptcy stakeholders, practitioners, academics, and policy influencers, with a focus on actionable insights for India's evolving insolvency framework.
- Dedicated sessions on cross-border insolvency, comparative perspectives, and cross-border cooperations on large cases.
- Roundtable with specialized U.S. bankruptcy practitioners and bar association committees on practical restructuring challenges and market practice.
- Interactive dialogue on India–U.S. insolvency practice and legal careers with diaspora and affinity bar groups, fostering cross-cultural professional linkages.
- Engagement with business chambers and policy-oriented institutions on distressed assets, enforcement risk, and investment opportunities in stressed sectors in India and the U.S.
- Structured networking receptions designed to build professional and institutional relationships.

- Participants must ensure full compliance with all applicable U.S. laws, visa conditions, and travel regulations. The organizers shall not be held responsible for Visa rejections, delays.
- The delegation fee will be refunded only in the event of visa denial. In such cases, a processing charge of INR 10,000 plus applicable GST will be deducted from the total amount paid.
