- The Government of the Republic of Kenya has received financing from the OPEC Fund for International Development (the OPEC Fund) towards the cost of the **Development of Urban Roads in Arid and Semi-Arid Areas (ASALs)** Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Construction of Wajir Town Roads. The project entails the construction and improvement of selected urban roads within Wajir Town aimed at enhancing mobility, accessibility, road safety, and socio-economic development. The estimated cost of the works is approximately **USD 35,000,000.00**
- The terms and conditions of the Contract and payments by the OPEC Fund shall be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. No party other than the Government of the Republic of Kenya shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the financing.
- The project involves upgrading thirty-one (31) town roads totalling to approximately sixty-five (65) Km to bitumen standards in Wajir Town, divided into three (3) Lots. The construction period shall be as specified in the bidding documents.
- Bidders shall have the option of submitting bids for one (1), two (2), or all the three (3) Lots but shall only be awarded a maximum of two (2) Lots in this tender.
- Bidding will be conducted through International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures in accordance with the OPEC Fund Procurement Guidelines. The procurement process shall be governed by the provisions of the Financing Agreement and the applicable OPEC Fund procurement requirements. Where necessary and to the extent not inconsistent with the OPEC Fund Procurement Guidelines, the procurement process may draw upon internationally recognized best practices, including principles embodied in the World Bank Procurement Framework and the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015 of Kenya, to promote economy, efficiency, transparency, fairness, integrity, and value for money.

- The Government of the Republic of Kenya has received a loan from the Export-Import Bank of Korea, from the resources of the Economic Development Cooperation Fund (EDCF) of the Republic of Korea, in the amount of **USD 83,834,000 (Eighty-Three Million Eight Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand United States Dollars)** toward payments under the Contract for the Design and Build of the Nairobi ITS Establishment and Junctions Improvement Project – Phase II.
- The terms and conditions of the Contract and payment by the Bank, therefore, shall be subject in all aspects to the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement, including the Guidelines for the procurement under the EDCF Loan (the guidelines). Except as the Bank may specifically otherwise agree, no party other than the Borrower shall derive any rights from the Loan Agreement or have any claims on the Loan Proceeds.
- The Project Executing Agency, Kenya Urban Roads Authority ("KURA" or the "Employer") now invites sealed bids from eligible Korean bidders for the implementation of the project as described in the below:
 - Implement the detailed design and construction of civil works for Improvement and upgrade of sixty (60) junctions' configuration to meet the adequate capacity for traffic demand;
 - Installation of ITS field equipment, including sixty (60) Traffic Signal Systems, sixty (60) CCTV cameras, thirteen (13) Vehicle Detector Systems (VDS), two (2) Variable Message Signs (VMS), sixty (60) Vehicle Enforcement Systems (VES), Street lights, etc;
 - Construction of a one (1) new bridge and extension of two (2) existing Bridges;
 - Training and skill transfer.
 - Dispatch of Experts for post-project O&M support during warranty period.

The Design-Build works, including commissioning and test operation, shall be completed within a period of **thirty (30) months** from the Commencement Date. Following the Taking Over of the Works, the Contractor shall provide and deploy experts for a period of four (4) years to provide operational support and to assist the Employer in achieving sustainable operation and maintenance of the Works.
