The consulting services ("the Services") include the provision of independent strategic public-private partnership advisory support to the Sri Lanka Ports Authority and the Government of Sri Lanka in relation to potential private sector participation in container terminals and related port infrastructure. The assignment is expected to require approximately nine calendar months from commencement until 30 April 2027.
